


Unfinished Size: 51/2" x 51/2"

What you need:

Patches	Quantity/size
A *	(2) 1" x 6"
B*	(2) 1" x 5"
C	(1) 6" x 6"- navy , cut twice diagonally (1) 6" x 6" - It blue, cut twice diagonally
D	Use remaining triangles from C

*The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is ¾". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly 5½".

Assembly:

- 1. Using templates on Page G1-2 and G1-3, foundation piece sections.
- 2. Assemble sections and sew together to make 2 quarter square triangle (QST) blocks.
- 3. Using the template provided on Page G1-4, cut clover shape from one of the QST blocks. Appliqué cut clover to remaining QST block as shown.
- 4. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
- 5. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square.






















Block G1 Appliqué Templates
