
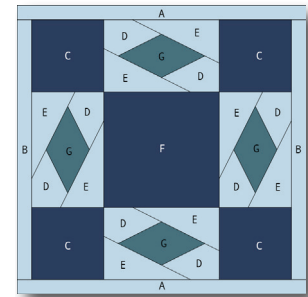


The Jane Stickle Quilt - Block G11

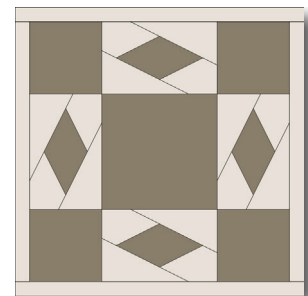


What you need:

Patches	Quantity/size
A*	(2) 1" x 6"
B*	(2) 1" x 5"
C	(4) 1¾" x 1¾"
D	(8) 1¾" x 1¾"
E 	(4) 1¾" x 3, cut one diagonally
F	(1) 2½" x 2½"
G	(4) 1½" x 2½"

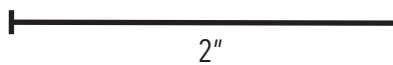
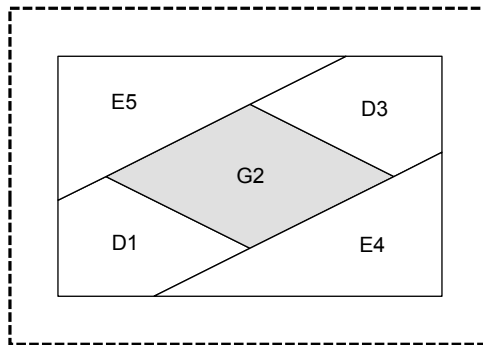
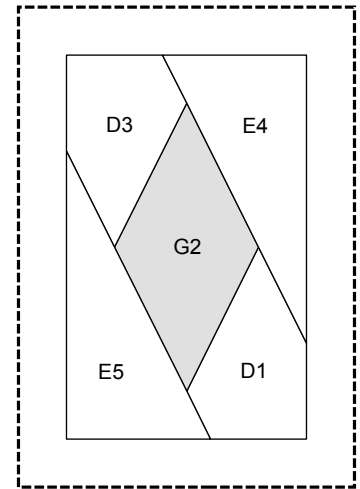
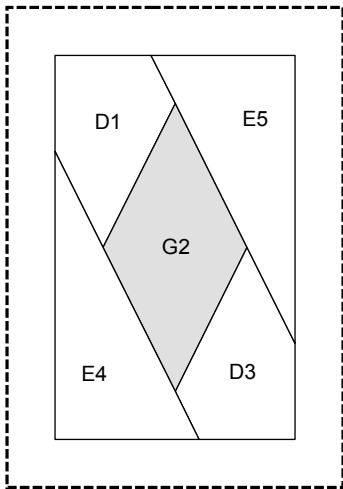
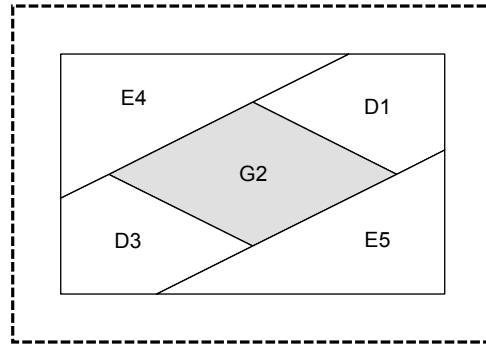
**The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is ¾". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly 5½".*

Assembly:

- Using templates on Page G11-2, foundation piece diamond sections.
- Sew a Unit C to each end of two Step 1 diamond patches.
- Sew the remaining two Step 1 patches to opposite sides of Unit F.
- Arrange the rows created in Step 2 and Step 3 as shown and sew together.
- Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
- Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure 5½" x 5½" square.



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
