

The Jane Stickle Quilt - Block H6




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
Unfinished Size: 51/2" x 51/2"

What you need:

| Patches | Quantity/size (foundation) | Quantity/size (traditional piecing) |
|-----------|--|--|
| A* | (2) 1" x 6" | (2) 1" x 6" |
| B* | (2) 1" x 5" | (2) 1" x 5" |
| С | (4) 2" x 2" | (4) 15/8" x 15/8" |
| D | (4) 2" x 3" | (4) 15/8" x 23/4" |
| E | (8) 1½" x 1½" - navy (4) 1½" x 1½" - light blue | (8) 1½" x 1½" - navy (1) 2¾" x 2¾"-light blue |
| F | (1) 3" x 3" | (1) 3" x 3" |

*The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is 34". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly 5½".

Assembly:

- 1. Using templates on Page H6-2 and H6-3, curve piece or appliqué two navy Unit E to Unit D. Make 4.
- 2. Using templates on Page H6-2 and H6-3, curve piece four light blue Unit E to one Unit F, OR appliqué one Unit F to light blue Unit E.
- 3. Sew Unit C to each side of two Step 1 patches.
- 4. Sew remaining two Step 1 patches to each side of Step 2 patch.
- 5. Arrange rows from Step 3 and Step 4 as shown and sew together.
- 6. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
- 7. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square.












Block H6 Foundation Templates
