


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


## What you need:

Patches	Quantity/size
A*	(2) 1″ x 6″
B*	(2) 1" x 5"
С	(2) <sup>7</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " x 5"
D	(2) <sup>7</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " x 4 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> "
E	(4) 1¾" x 1¾" - light blue (1) 1¾" x 1¾" - green
F	(2) 2½" x 2½" - light blue (2) 2½" x 2½" - navy


## Assembly:

- 1. Referring to BASIC INSTRUCTIONS, make 4 HST units using the Unit F patches.
- 2. On the reverse side of one HST unit, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner opposite the seam. Align with second HST unit right sides together, with contrasting colors facing each other. Sew two seams, each 1/4" away from drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line and press open. Repeat the process for a total of 4 quarter-square triangle (QST) units. The QST units should measure 1¾" x 1¾" square.

units is <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>". The increased width specified above


allows for squaring the block to exactly 51/2".

- 3. Sew a light blue Unit E to each side of two QST units. Sew the remaining QST units to each side of green Unit E as shown.
- 4. Join Unit D to the top of the block, and then the bottom.
- 5. Join Unit C to the right side of the block, and then the left.
- 6. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
- 7. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square.





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
