

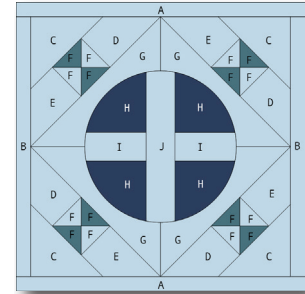


The Jane Stickle Quilt - Block H8

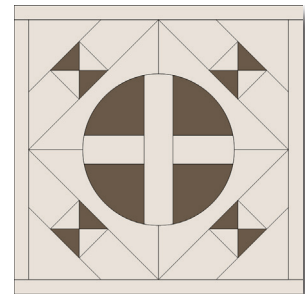


What you need:

Patches	Quantity/size
A*	(2) 1" x 6"
B*	(2) 1" x 5"
C 	(2) 2½" x 2½", cut once diagonally
D	(4) 1½" x 2½"
E	(4) 1½" x 2½"
F 	(4) 2" x 2" - green, cut once diagonally (4) 2" x 2" - lt blue, cut once diagonally
G	(4) 1½" x 5"
H	(4) 2" x 2"
I	(2) 1" x 2"
J	(1) 1" x 4"

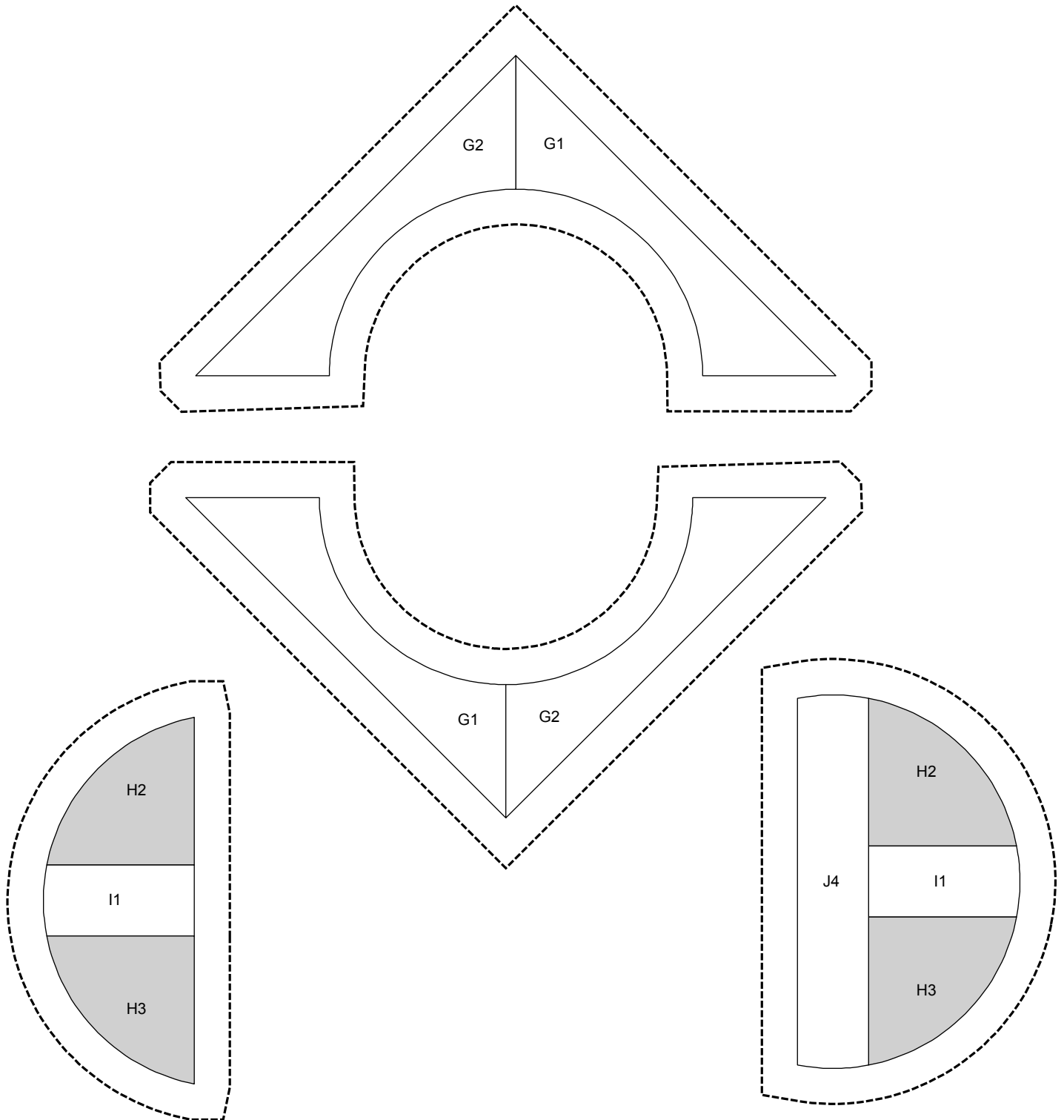
**The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is ¾". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly 5½".*

Assembly:

- Using templates on Page H8-2, foundation piece sections.
- Assemble inner circle sections and sew together. Join foundation halves and appliqué to circle patch.
- Using the template provided on Page H8-3, foundation piece sections. Sew corners to Step 2 patch.
- Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
- Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure 5½" x 5½" square.

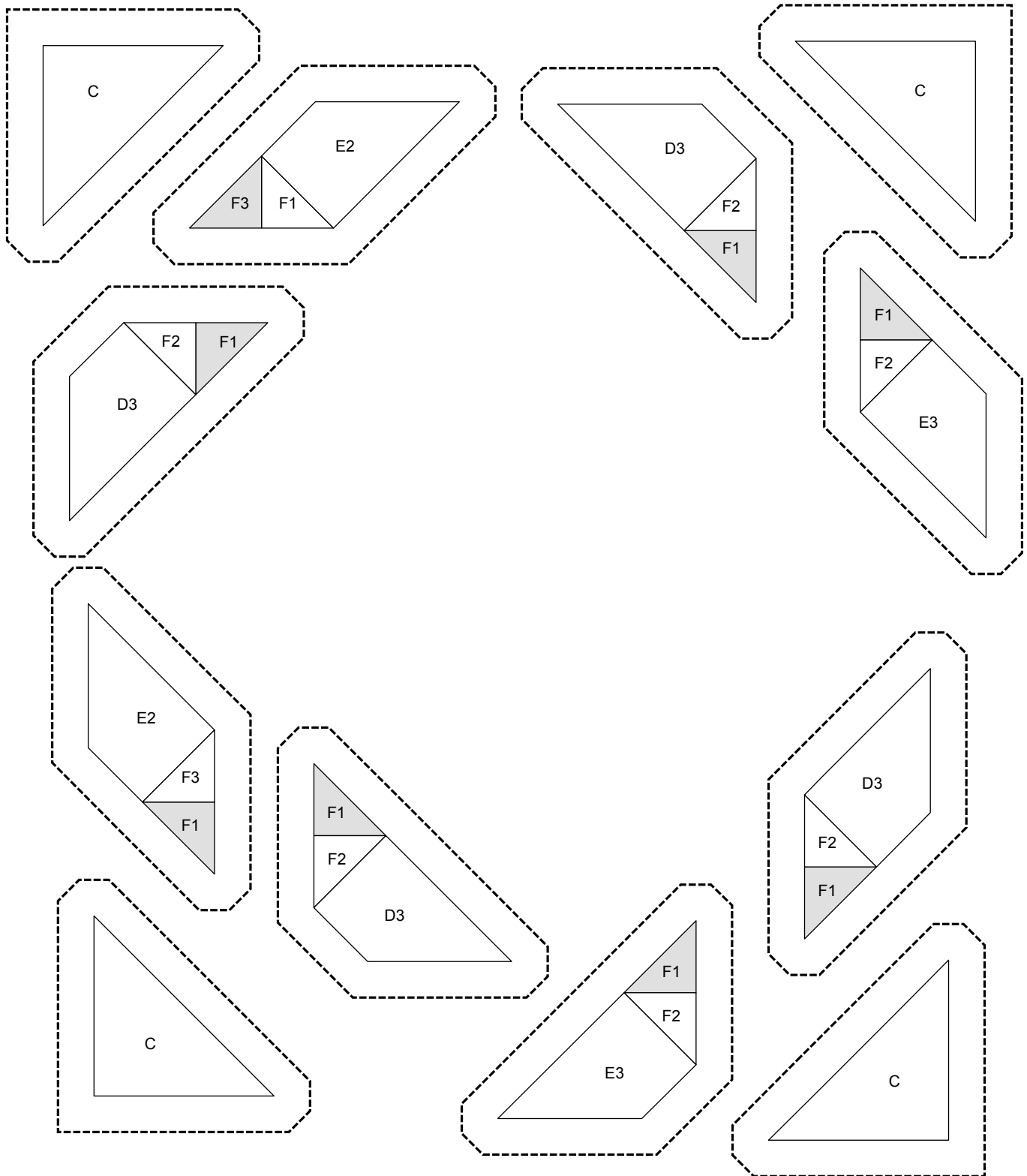


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
