

## The Jane Stickle Quilt - Block H10




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
Unfinished Size: 5½" x 5½"

#### What you need:

Patches	Quantity/size
<b>A</b> *	(2) 1" x 6"
B*	(2) 1" x 5"
С	(2) 2¾" x 2¾" - navy (2) 2¾" x 2¾" - light blue
D	(4) 15/8" x 2 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> "
E	(1) 2" x 2" - light blue (1) 2" x 2" - green
F	(2) 1%" x 1%" - green
	*The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is 34". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly 5½".

### Assembly:

- 1. Referring to BASIC INSTRUCTIONS, make 2 HST units using the Unit E patches.
- 2. Assemble and sew together a four-patch unit using the Step 1 HST patches and two Unit F patches.
- 3. Referring to BASIC INSTRUCTIONS, make 4 HST units using the Unit C patches.
- 4. On the reverse side of one HST unit, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner opposite the seam. Align with second HST unit right sides together, with contrasting colors facing each other. Sew two seams, each 1/4" away from drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line and press open. Repeat the process for a total of 4 quarter-square triangle (QST) units. The QST units should measure 15%" x 15%" square.
- 5. Sew a Step 4 QST to each side of two Unit D as shown. Sew the remaining two Unit D to each side Step 2 center patch as shown. Sew together the three rows.
- 6. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
- 7. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square.














# Block H10 Hand Piecing Templates
