

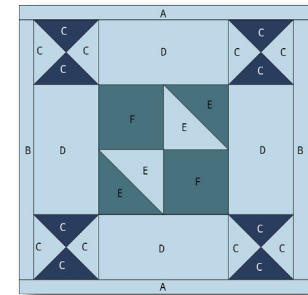
The Jane Stickle Quilt - Block H10



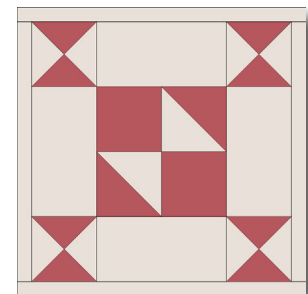
What you need:

Patches	Quantity/size
A*	(2) 1" x 6"
B*	(2) 1" x 5"
C	(2) 2⅜" x 2⅜" - navy (2) 2⅜" x 2⅜" - light blue
D	(4) 1⅝" x 2¾"
E	(1) 2" x 2" - light blue (1) 2" x 2" - green
F	(2) 1⅝" x 1⅝" - green

**The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is ¾". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly 5½".*



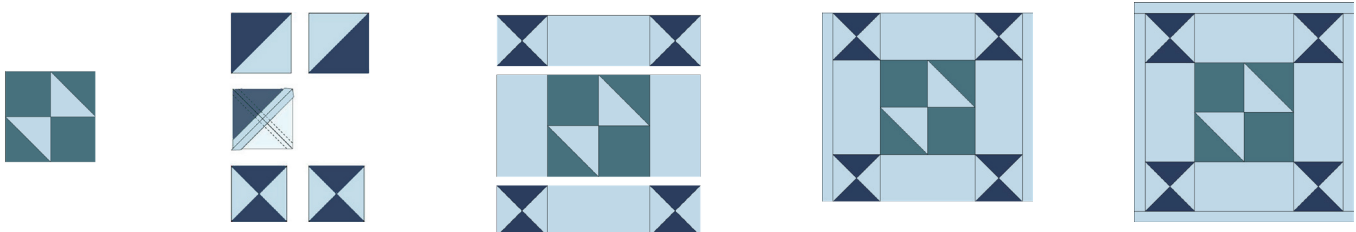

Assembly:

- Referring to BASIC INSTRUCTIONS, make 2 HST units using the Unit E patches.
- Assemble and sew together a four-patch unit using the Step 1 HST patches and two Unit F patches.
- Referring to BASIC INSTRUCTIONS, make 4 HST units using the Unit C patches.
- On the reverse side of one HST unit, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner opposite the seam. Align with second HST unit right sides together, with contrasting colors facing each other. Sew two seams, each ¼" away from drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line and press open. Repeat the process for a total of 4 quarter-square triangle (QST) units. The QST units should measure 1⅝" x 1⅝" square.
- Sew a Step 4 QST to each side of two Unit D as shown. Sew the remaining two Unit D to each side Step 2 center patch as shown. Sew together the three rows.
- Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
- Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure 5½" x 5½" square.



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
