3. Sew a light blue Unit E to each side of two OST units. Sew the remaining OST units to each side of green Unit E as shown.
4. Join Unit D to the top of the block, and then the bottom.

7. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure $5 \frac{1}{1} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51^{\prime \prime}$ " square.

6. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
