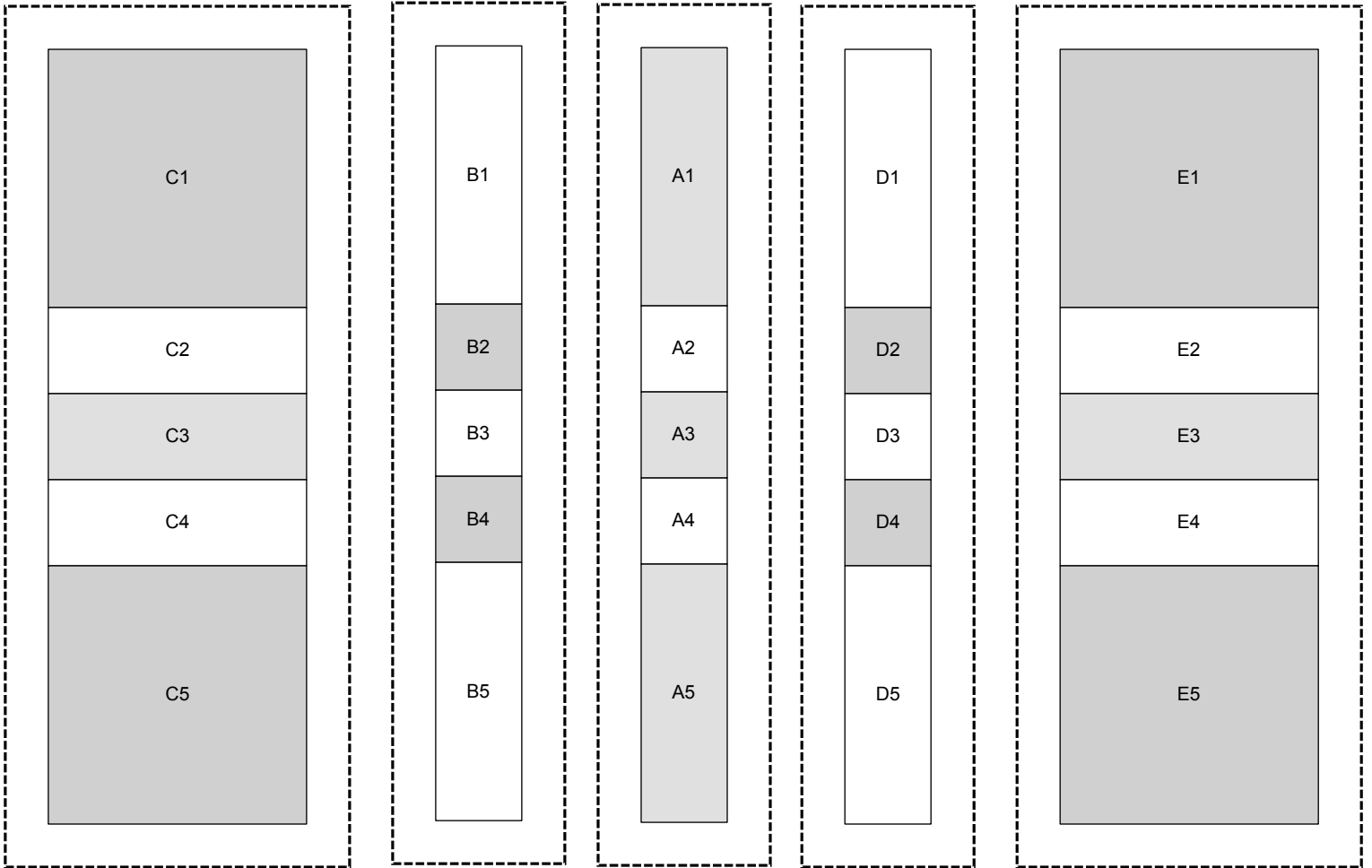
Foundation Templates have been included as an option to traditional piecing. If you choose to foundation piece, I recommend increasing the cutting sizes for Units C, D, and E by ½ inch.

Assembly:

1. Sew two navy Unit E to opposite sides of one light blue Unit E. Repeat to make a second set.
2. Sew two light blue Unit E to opposite sides of one green Unit E.
3. Assemble rows from Step 1 and Step 2 as shown and sew together.
4. Sew two light blue Unit D to opposite sides of green Unit D. Repeat to make a total of four sets.
5. Sew two unit C to opposite sides of Step 4 patch as shown and sew together. Repeat to make a second set.
6. Sew remaining patches from Step 4 to opposite sides of Step 3 patch as shown.
7. Arrange rows from Step 5 and Step 6 as shown and sew together.
8. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
9. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure 5½" x 5½" square.

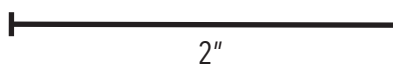
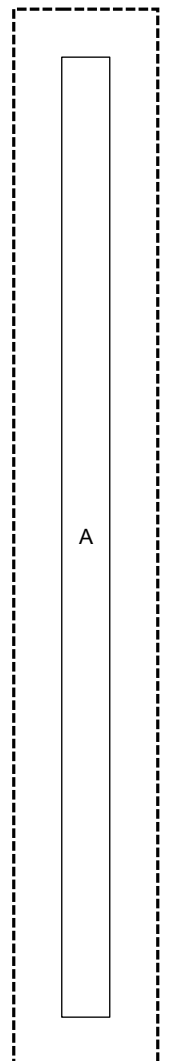
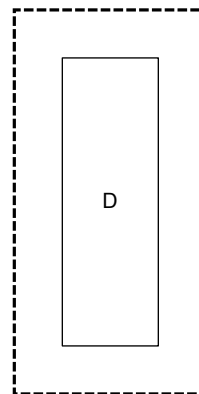
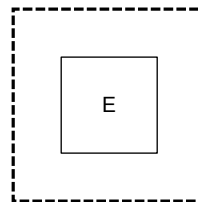
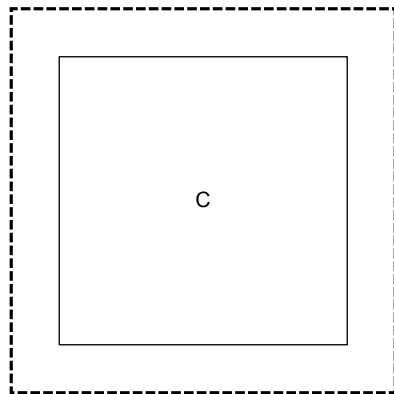
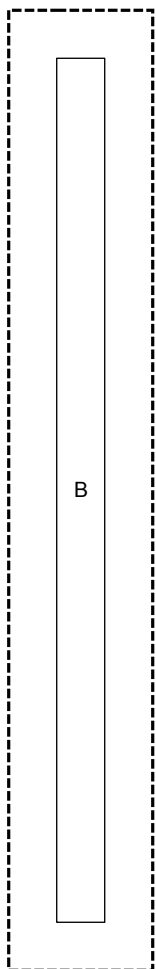
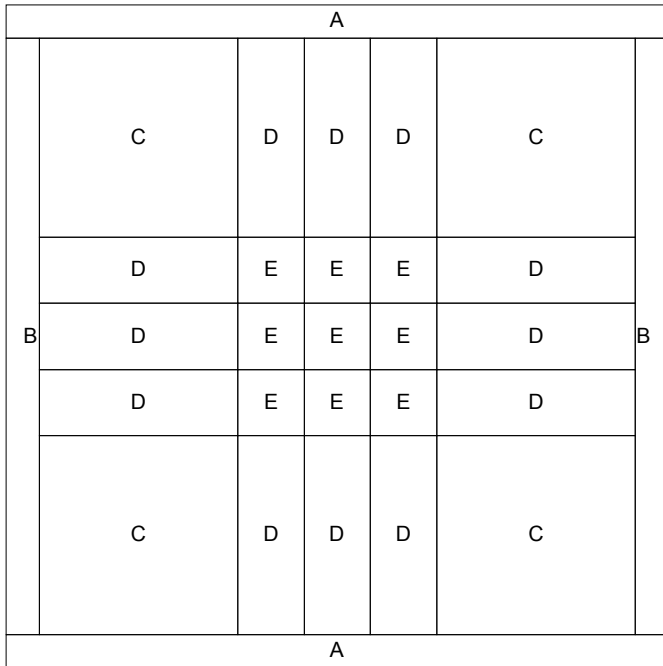


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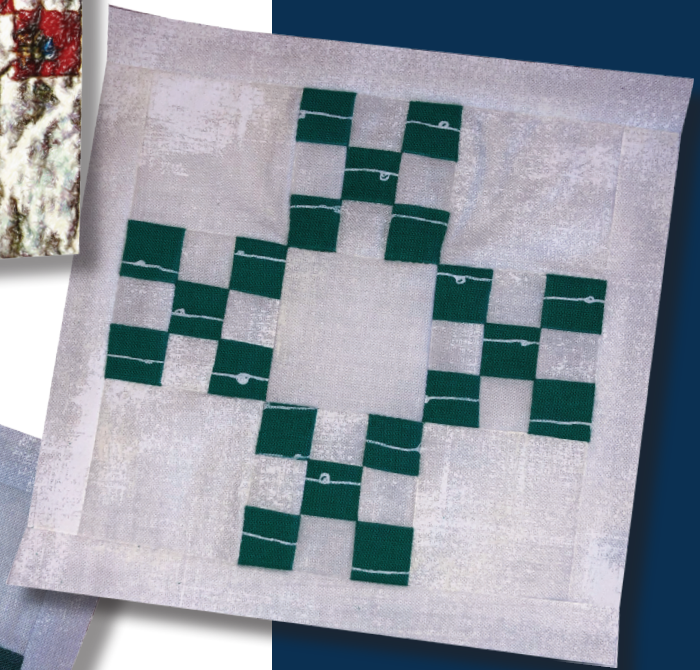
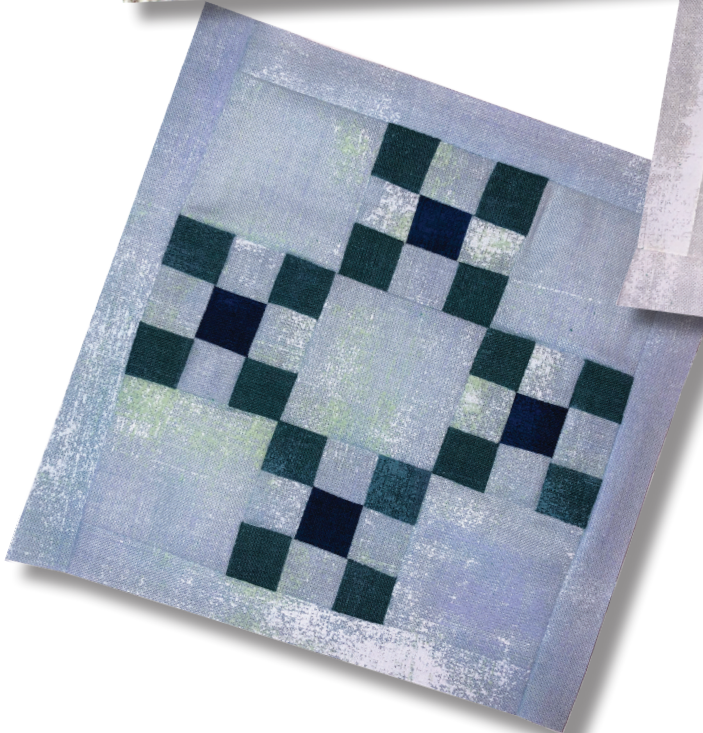
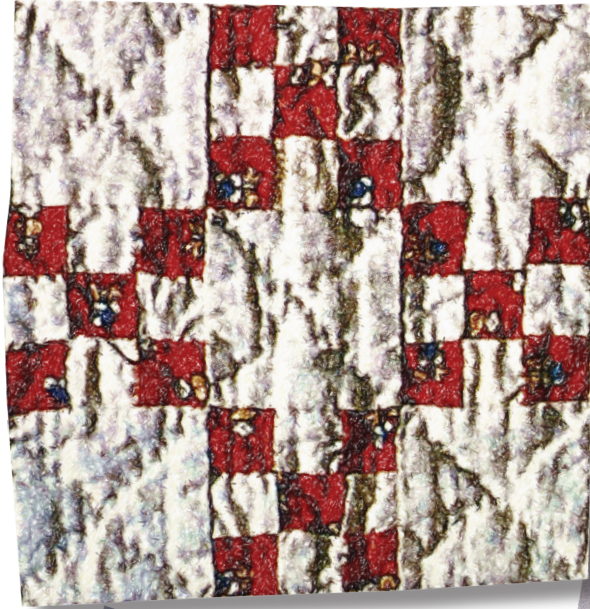

2. Arrange navy Unit E between two light blue Unit E and sew together. Cut into four 1" x 2" units.
3. Arrange one Step 2 unit between two Step 1 units and sew together. Repeat for a total of four nine-patch units.
4. Arrange one Step 3 nine-patch unit between two Unit C and sew together. Repeat for a total of two rows.
5. Arrange one Unit C between remaining two Step 3 nine-patch units and sew together.
6. Arrange Step 5 row between the two Step 4 rows. Sew together.
7. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
8. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure 5½" x 5½" square.





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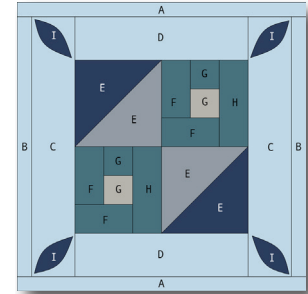
