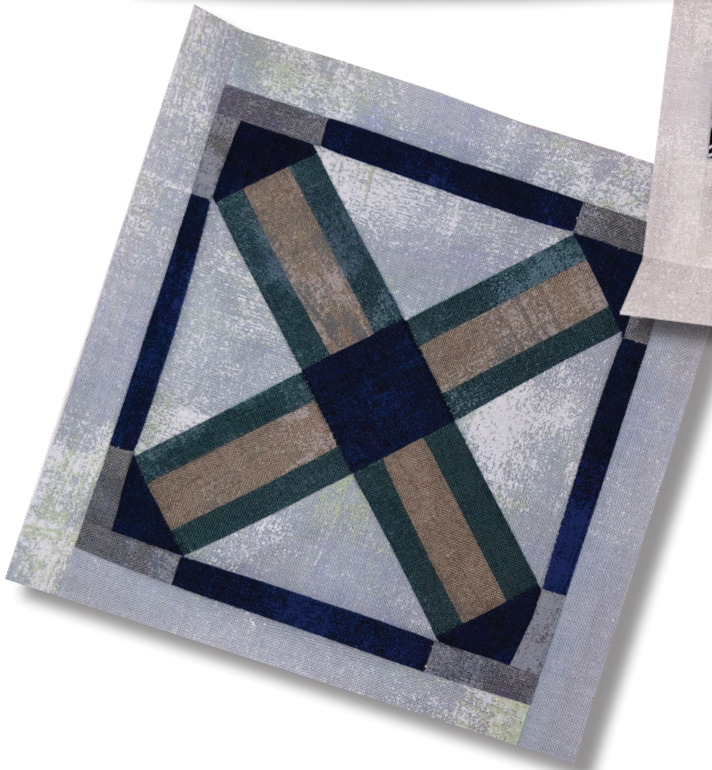
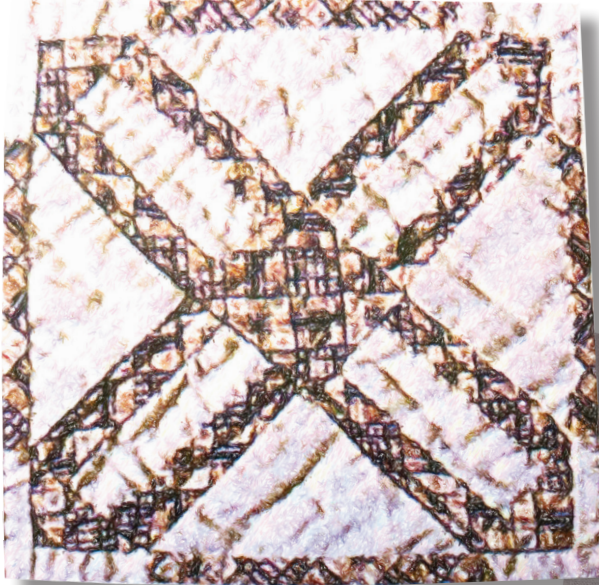


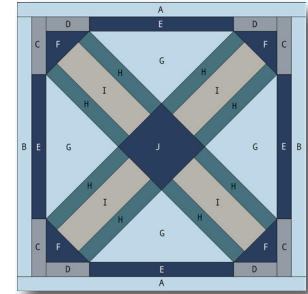


The Jane Stickle Quilt - Block K6

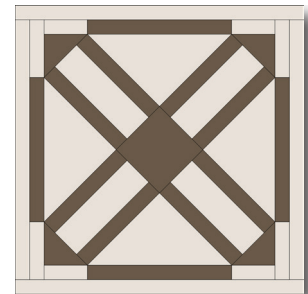


What you need:

Patches	Quantity/size
A*	(2) 1" x 6"
B*	(2) 1" x 5"
C	(4) 1" x 2" - gray
D	(4) 1" x 1½" - gray
E	(4) 1" x 3½" - navy
F	 (2) 2" x 2" - cut once diagonally
G	 (1) 4" x 4" - cut twice diagonally
H	(8) 1" x 2½"
I	(4) 1½" x 2½"
J	(1) 2" x 2"

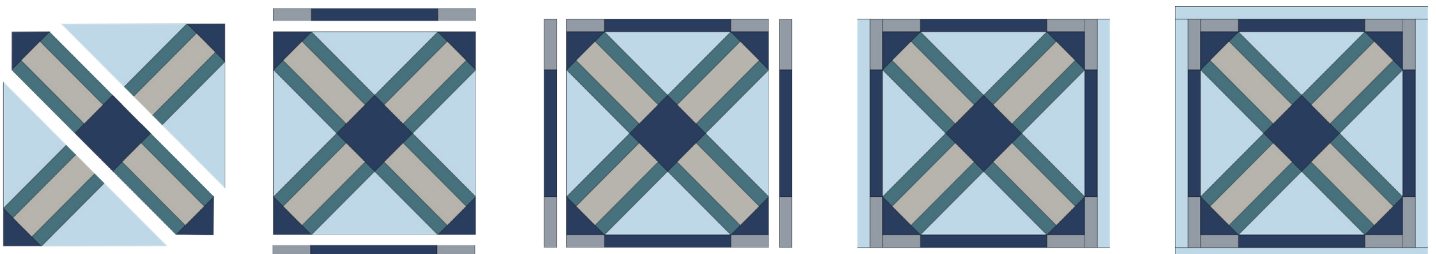


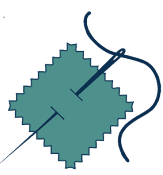

**The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is ¾". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly 5½".*

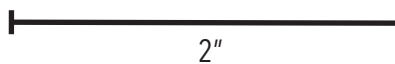
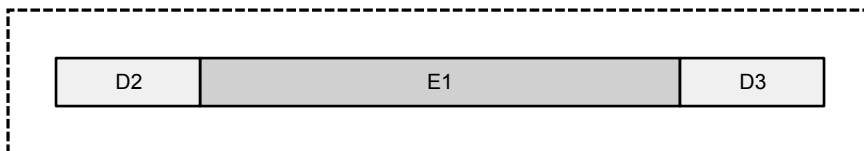
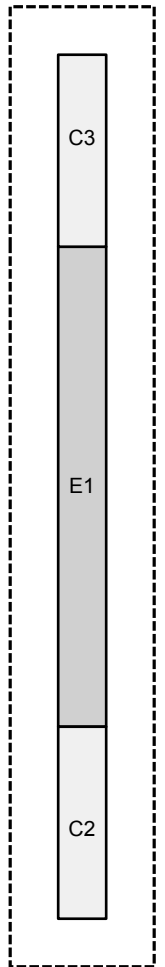
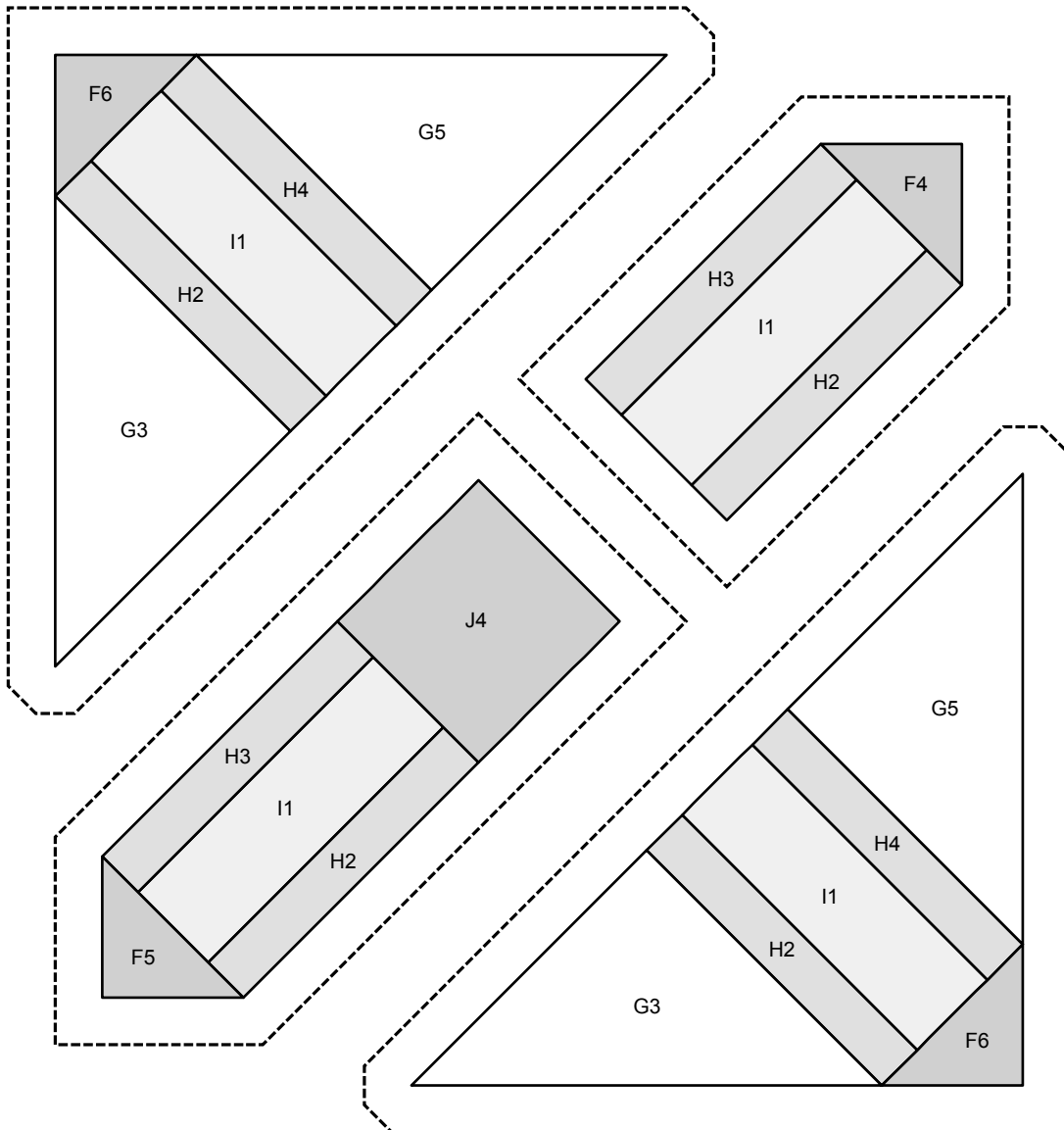
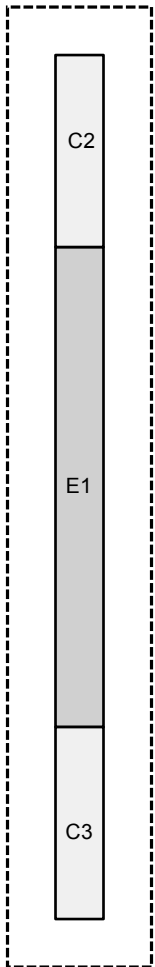
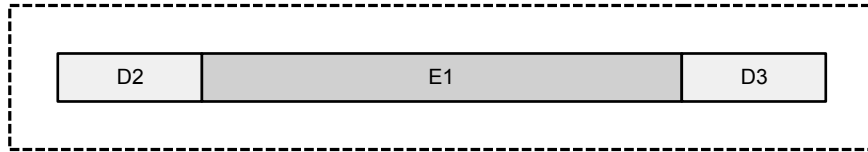
Assembly:

1. Using templates on Page K6-2, foundation piece sections.
2. Assemble sections and sew together.
3. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
4. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure 5½" x 5½" square.





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
