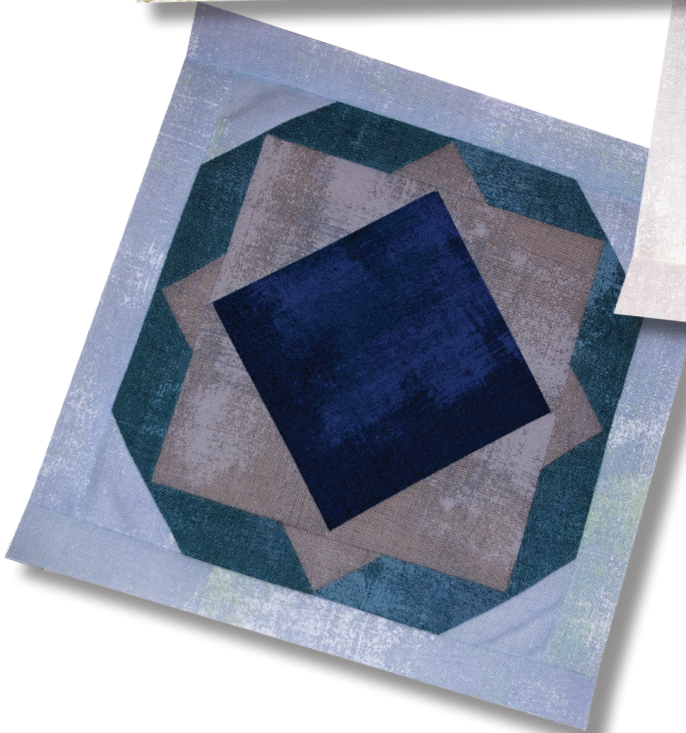



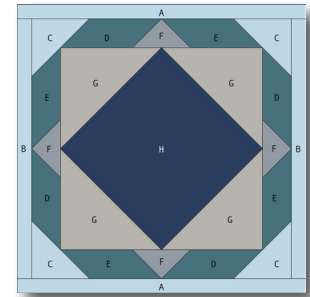


The Jane Stickle Quilt - Block L11

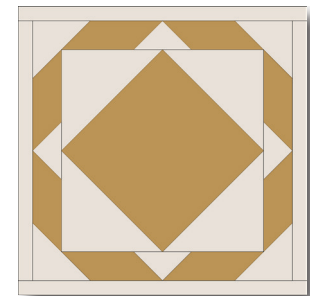


What you need:

Patches	Quantity/size
A*	(2) 1" x 6"
B*	(2) 1" x 5"
C	 (2) 2½" x 2½" - cut once diagonally
D	(4) 1½" x 3½"
E	(4) 1½" x 3½"
F	 (1) 3" x 3" - cut twice diagonally
G	 (2) 3" x 3" - cut once diagonally
H	(1) 3½" x 3½"

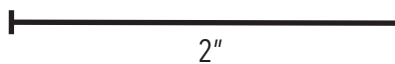
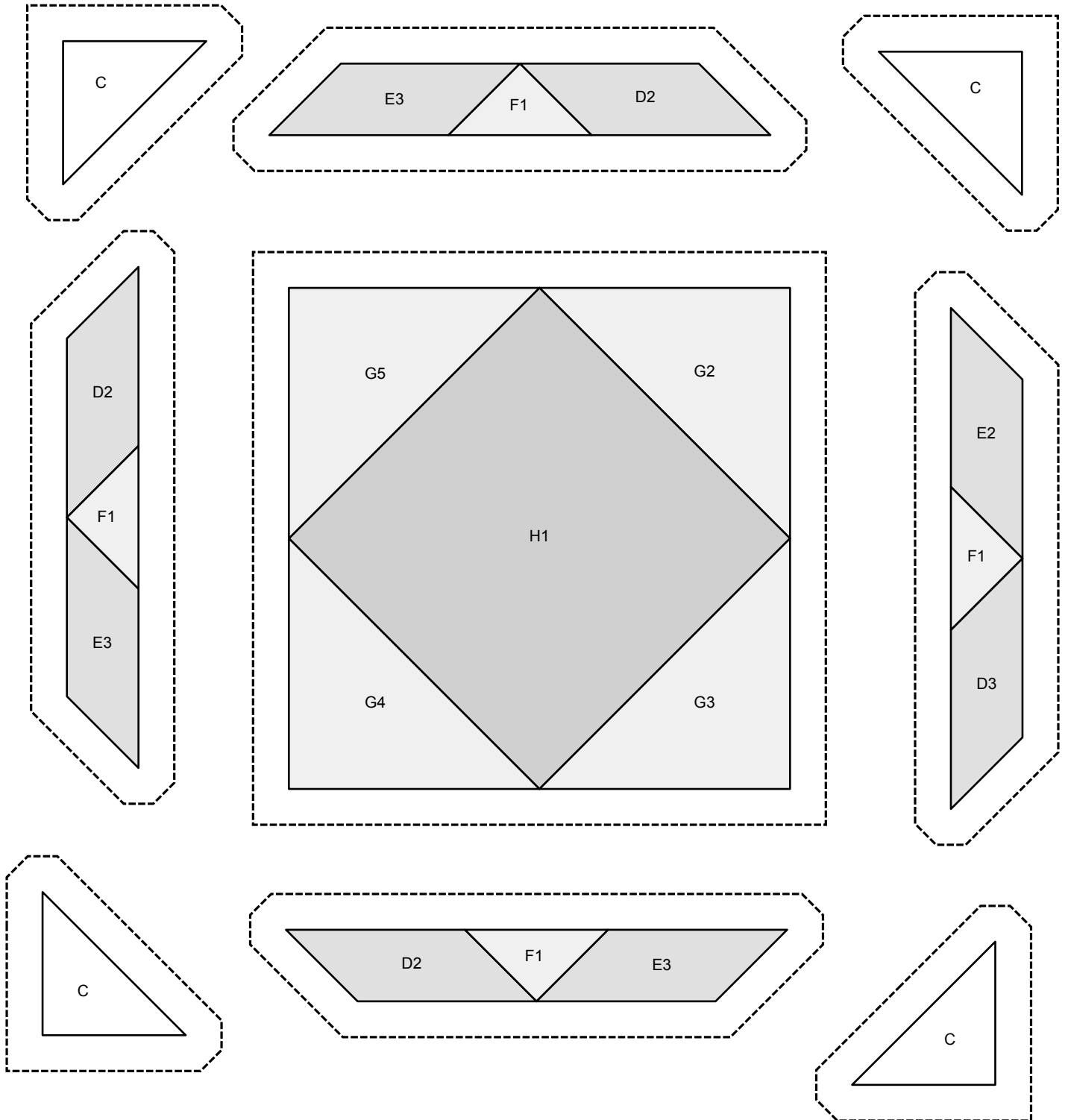
**The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is ¾". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly 5½".*

Assembly:

1. Using templates on Page L11-2, foundation piece sections. Arrange and sew together.
2. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
3. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure 5½" x 5½" square.



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
