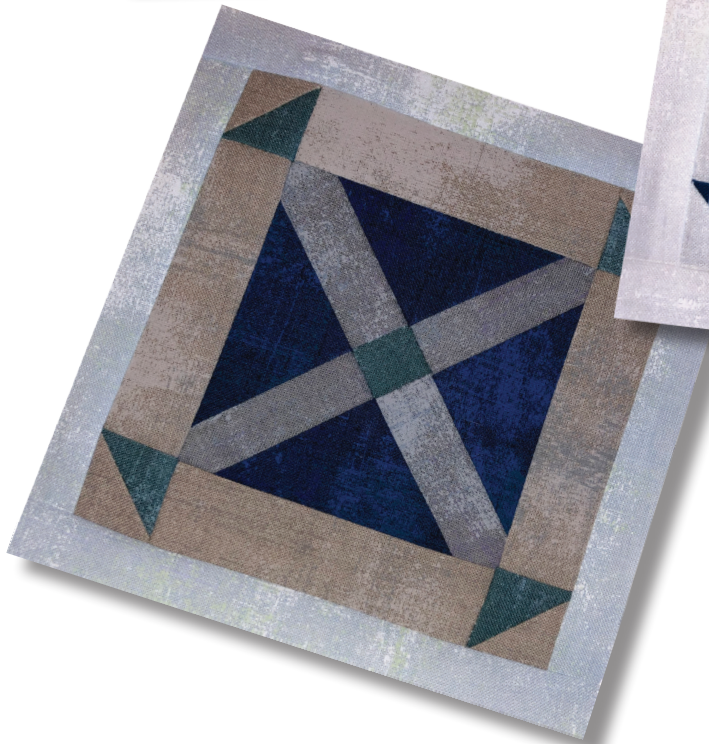



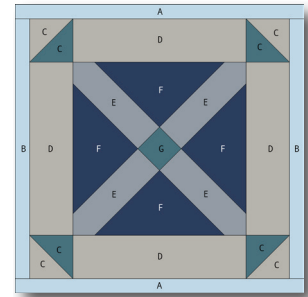


## The Jane Stickle Quilt - Block M2

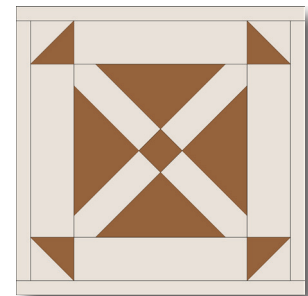


### What you need:

Patches	Quantity/size
A*	(2) 1" x 6"
B*	(2) 1" x 5"
C	 (2) 2" x 2" - green, cut once diagonally  (2) 2" x 2" - beige, cut once diagonally
D	(4) 1½" x 4" - beige
E	(4) 1½" x 3" - gray
F	 (1) 4" x 4" - navy, cut twice diagonally
G	(1) 1½" x 1½" - green

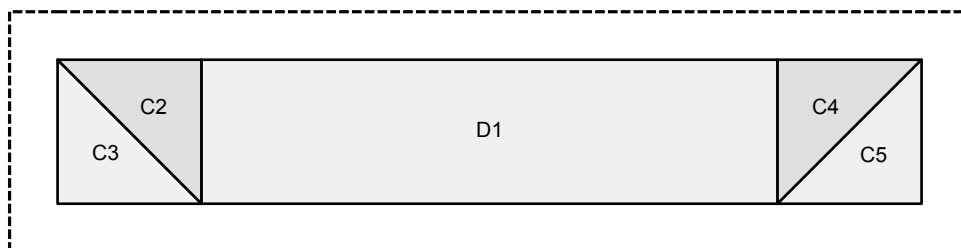
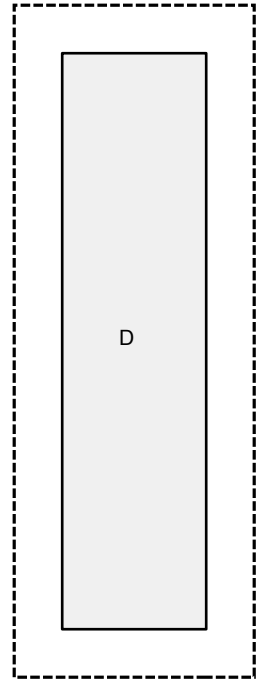
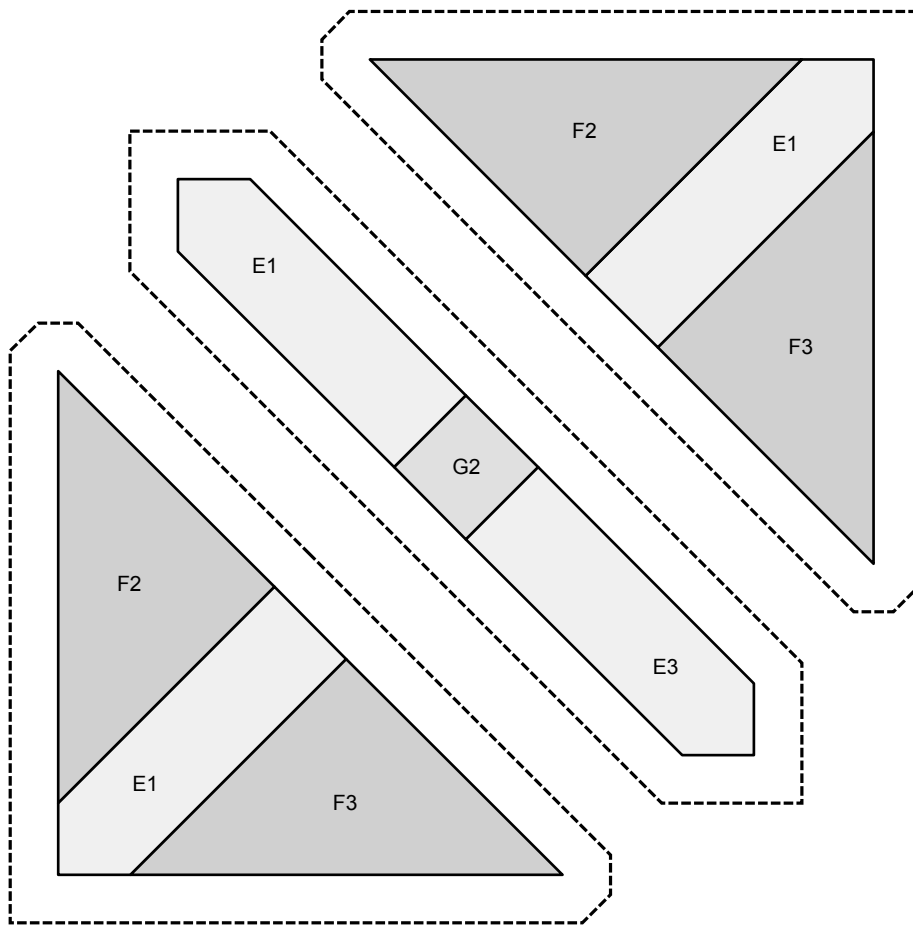
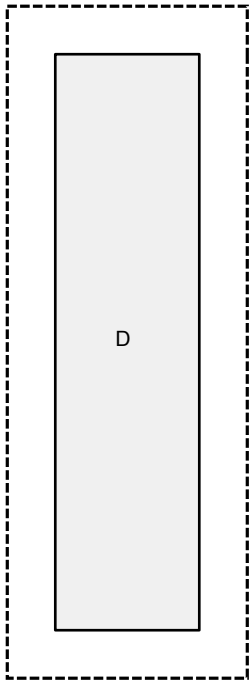
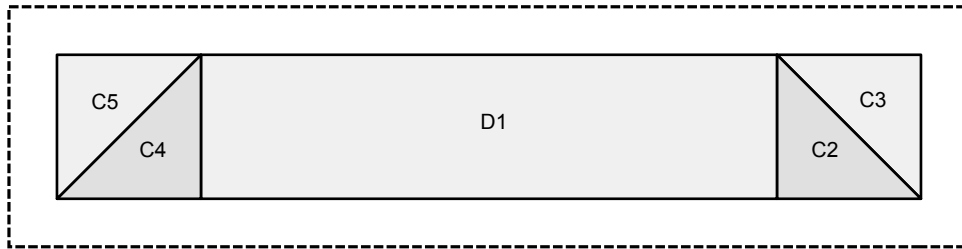
*\*The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is ¾". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly 5½".*

### Assembly:

1. Using templates on Page M2-2, foundation piece sections. Arrange and sew together.
2. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
3. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure 5½" x 5½" square.
