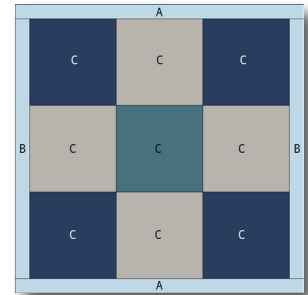


## The Jane Stickle Quilt - Block M10

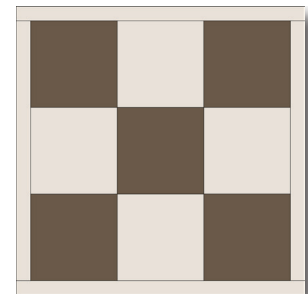


### What you need:

Patches	Quantity/size
A*	(2) 1" x 6"
B*	(2) 1" x 5"
C	(4) 2" x 2" - navy (4) 2" x 2" - beige (1) 2" x 2" - green

*\*The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is ¾". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly 5½".*

### Assembly:

1. Sew two navy Unit C to opposite sides of one beige Unit C. Repeat to make a second identical row.
2. Sew two beige Unit C to opposite sides of one green Unit C.
3. Arrange the three rows as shown and sew together.
4. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
5. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure 5½" x 5½" square.
