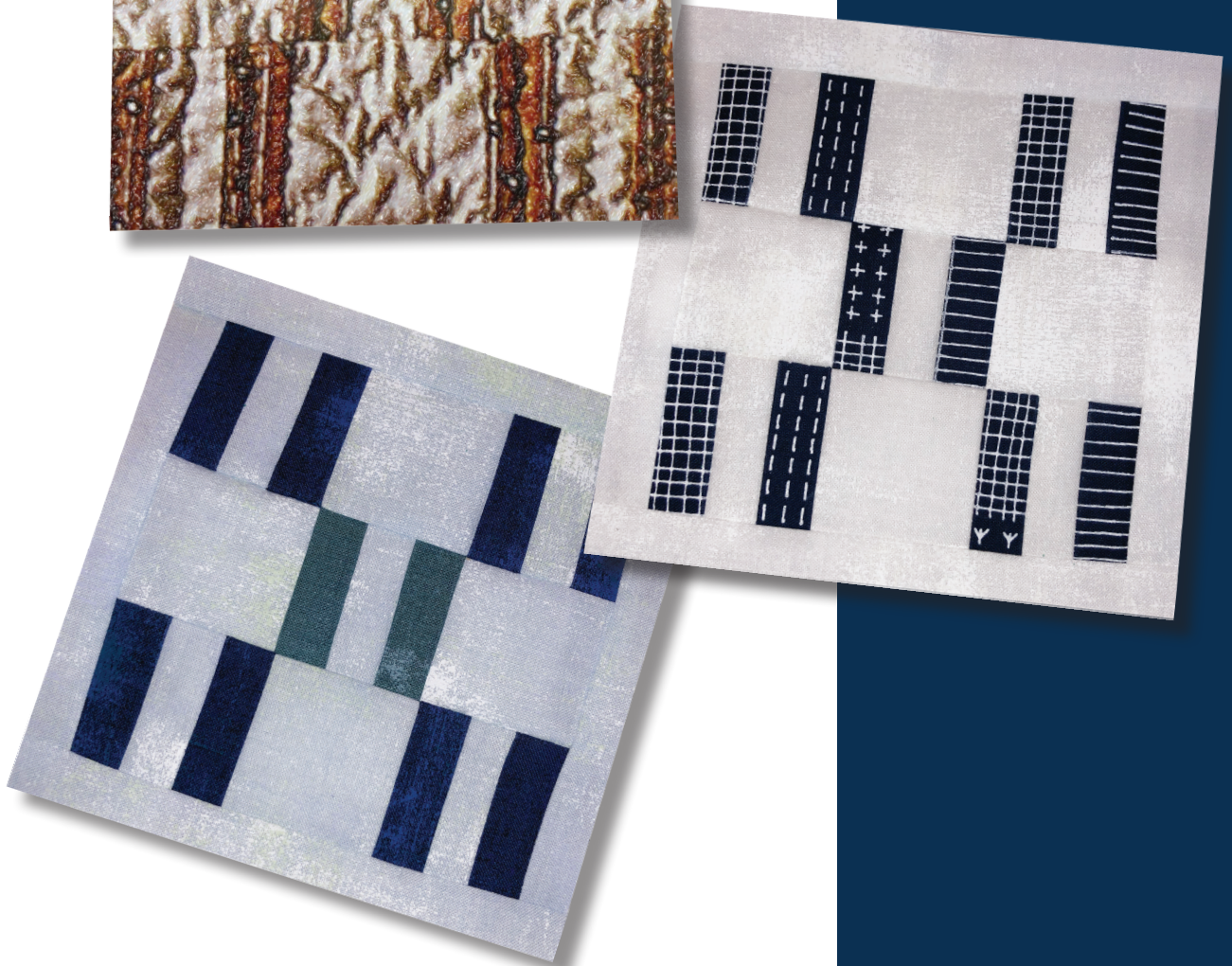


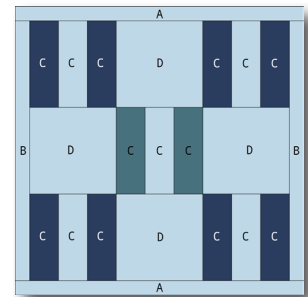
## The Jane Stickle Quilt - Block M12



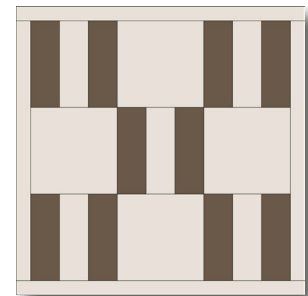
### What you need:

Patches	Quantity/size
A*	(2) 1" x 6"
B*	(2) 1" x 5"
C	(8) 1" x 2" - navy (5) 1" x 2" - light blue (2) 1" x 2" - green
D	(4) 2" x 2"

*\*The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is ¾". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly 5½".*



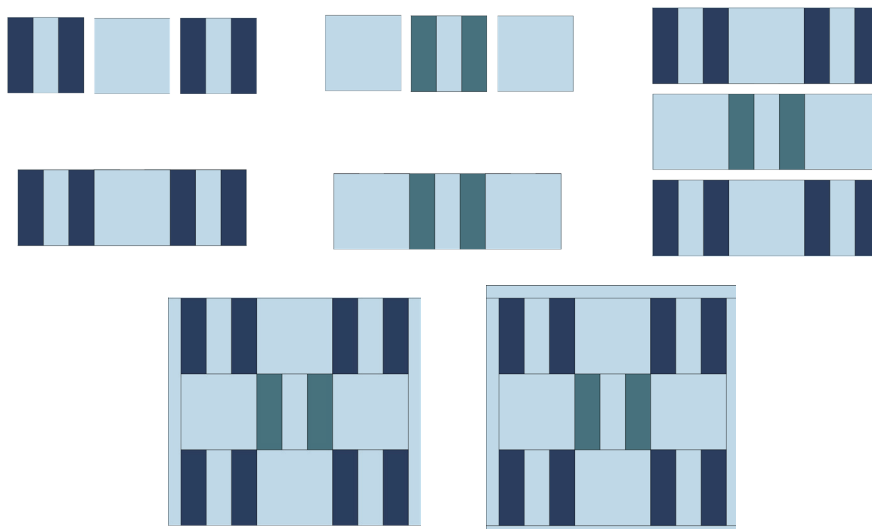

### Assembly:

1. Sew two navy Unit C to opposite sides of one light blue Unit C. Repeat three more time to make four striped blocks.
2. Sew two Step 1 blocks to opposite sides of one Unit D. Repeat to make a second row.
3. Sew two green Unit C to opposite sides of one light blue Unit C.
4. Sew two Unit D to opposite sides of one Step 3 block.
5. Arrange and sew together rows from Step 2 and row from Step 4.
6. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
7. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure 5½" x 5½" square.



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
