## Topsy Turvy Baby Quilt



Finished Size: 44" x 44"
Finished Block Size: 10" x 10"

## Fabric Requirements

## What you need for each block:

| Unit | ( Quantity) Size |

| A | (1) $/ 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " |
| B | (2) $/ 21 / 2$ " $\times 61 / 2$ |
| C | (2) $/ 2^{1 / 2 "} \times 8^{1 / 2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ |
| D | (1) $/ 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ |
| E | (1) $/ 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " |

## Assembly:

The pattern has been designed to use four different colors for the inner rounds of the blocks. Each color will be used four times for the inner middle round and four times for the outer middle round. Unit A is used to for the print selected (fussy cut if desired). And the outer round is for the background fabric. The color combinations are entirely up to you.

Assemble and sew together each block as shown below. As each piece is added, press seam towards that piece before attaching the next piece in the sequence..


## What you need:

| Unit | Quantity/Size |

| Block | $16 / 101 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ |
| Left/Right Border | 2 / $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ |
| Top/Bottom Border | 2 / $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 441 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ |
| Backing | 2 / width of fabric $\times 54$ " |
| Backing | $54 " \times 54 "$ piece |
| Binding | $5 / 21 / 2$ " x width of fabric |

## Assembly:

Assemble rows of blocks alternating Row 1 and Row 2 as shown. Press seams towards the yellow outer edge of the ajoining block in each row.

Join the rows as shown..
Border - cut five strips $21 / 2$ " $x$ width of fabric. Sew together end to end. From the long strip, cut two strips for the left and right borders ( $401 / 2$ ") and two strips for the top and bottom borders ( $441 / 2$ "). Attach the left and right borders. Then attach the top and bottom borders.

Backing - cut yardage into two 54" long pieces. Trim width to each piece to 27 " wide. Arrange together side by side and sew together to create backing sized about 54 " wide by 54 " long.

Binding - sew the five strips together end to end. Fold in half lengthwise and press.

Layer top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired. Sew on binding.
