## What you need:

| Patches | Quantity/size |

| A* $^{*}$ | (2) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ |
| B* $^{*}$ | (2) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ |
| C | (1) $6^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ |
| D | (4) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ |

D (4) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$
*The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is $3 / 4$.". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly $512^{2 \prime}$.

## Assembly:

1. Using the templates provided on page A3-2, applique the four leaf units to Unit $C$ of the block. When all the leaves have been appliquéed to Square C, trim the block to $5^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ square.
2. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
3. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure $51^{1 / 2} \times 5^{1 / 2 "}$.
