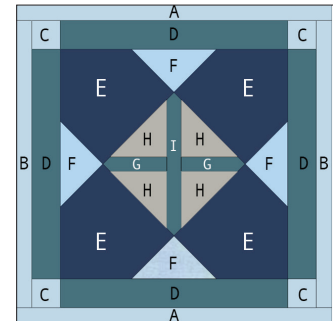


The Jane Stickle Quilt - Block A4

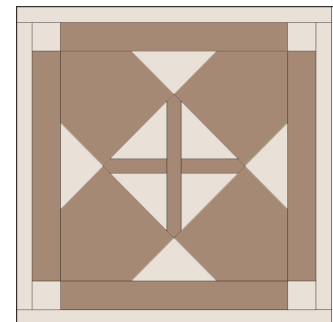


What you need:

Units	Quantity/size
A*	(2) 1" x 6"
B*	(2) 1" x 5"
C	(4) 1" x 1"
D	(4) 1" x 4½"
E	(4) 3" x 3"
F	(4) 2½" x 2½"
G	(2) 1" x 2"
H	(4) 2" x 2"
I	(1) 1" x 3"

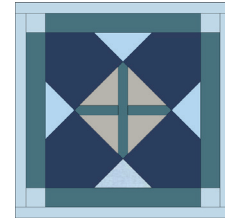
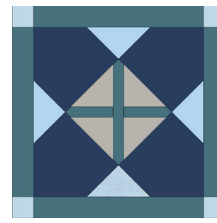


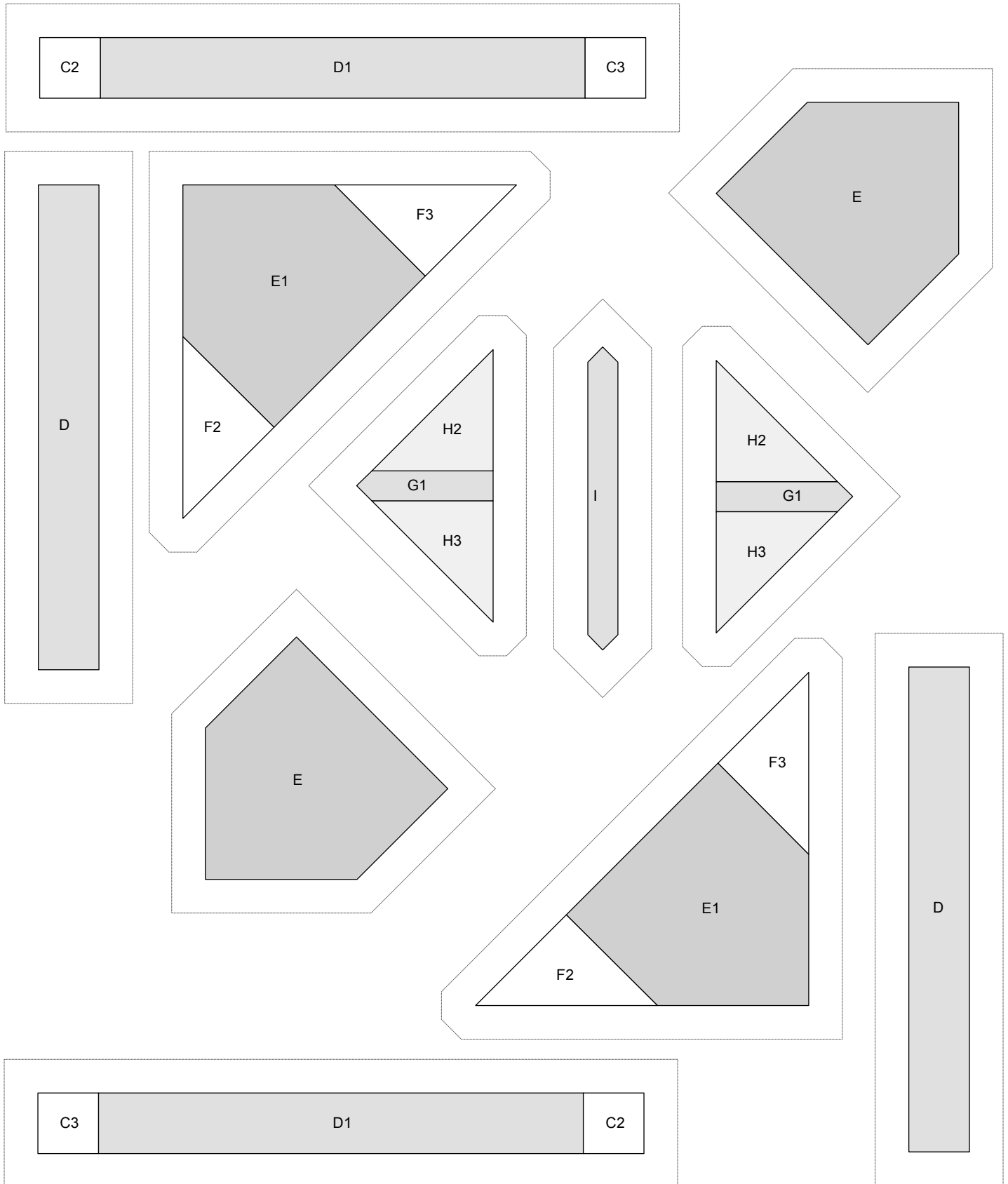

**The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is ¾". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly 5½".*

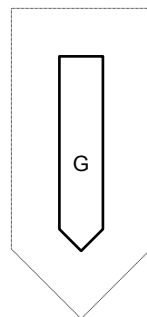
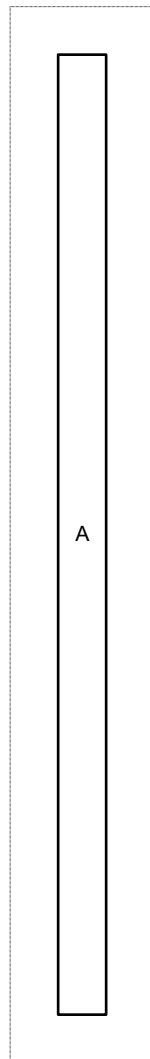
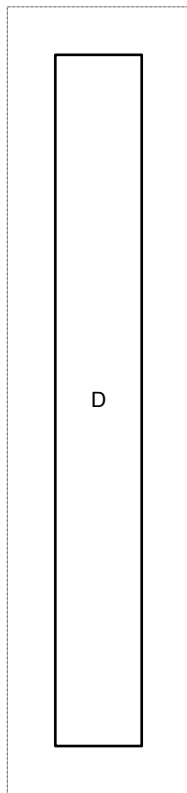
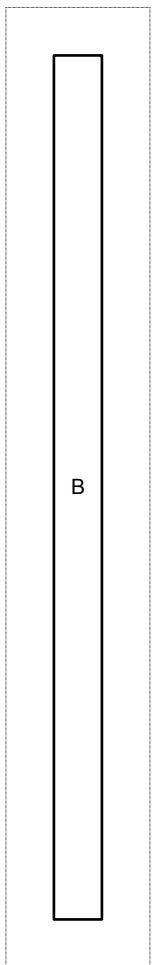
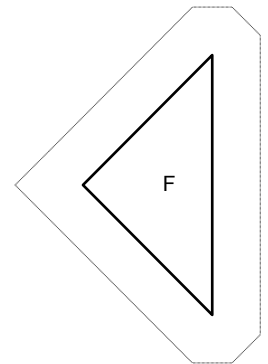
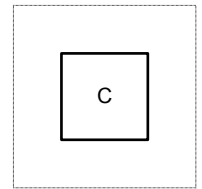
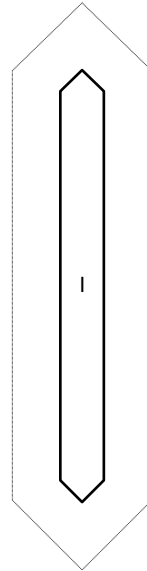
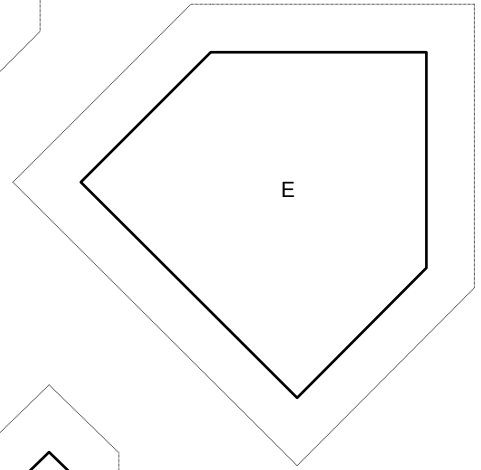
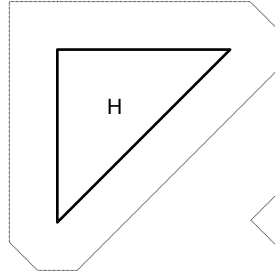
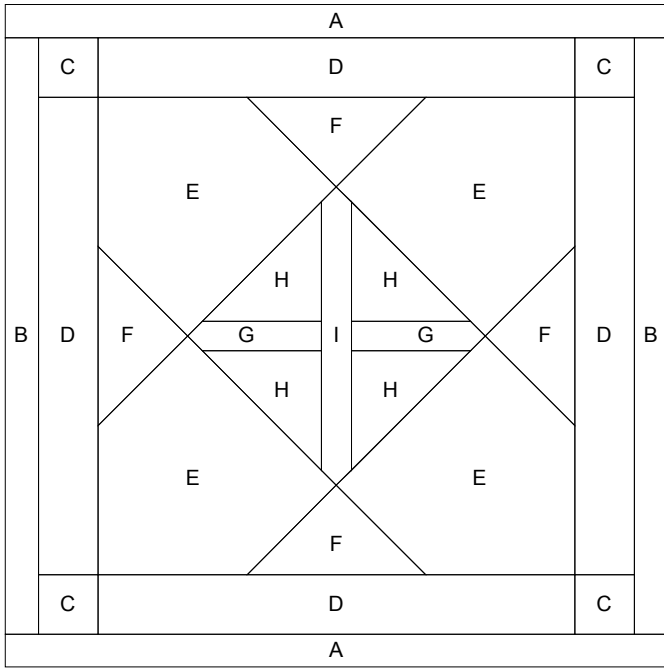
1. Use the templates provided on Page A4-2 to foundation piece the sections of the block. Attach each fabric unit in the order numbered for each section. Join the sections, using the below images for reference. The unfinished block should be 5" x 5" at this point.
2. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
3. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure 5½" x 5½".
