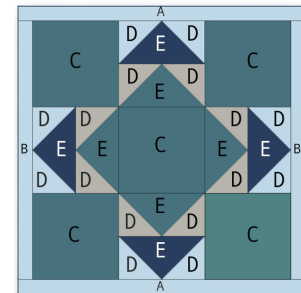


## The Jane Stickle Quilt - Block A5

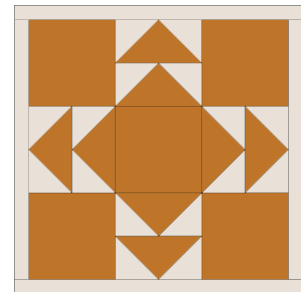


### What you need:

Patches	Quantity/size
A*	(2) 1" x 6"
B*	(2) 1" x 5"
C	5 squares 2" x 2"
D	8 squares 1¼" x 1¼" (light blue) 8 squares 1¼" x 1¼" (beige)
E	4 rectangles 1¼" x 2" (navy) 4 rectangles 1¼" x 2" (green)

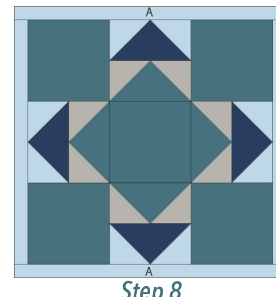
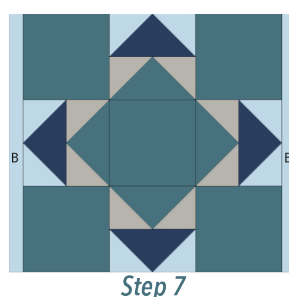
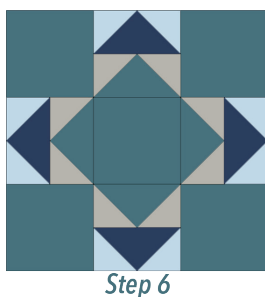
\*The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is ¾". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly 5½".

### Assembly:

1. Referring to BASIC INSTRUCTIONS for stitch-and-flip flying geese, layer two light blue Unit D with one navy Unit E using the stitch and flip method. Make four.
2. Repeat procedure using beige Unit D and green Unit E. Make four.
3. Arrange flying geese units from Step 1 and Step 2. Sew together as shown. Make four.
4. Join a Unit C to each side of a flying geese block from Step 3 as shown. Make two.

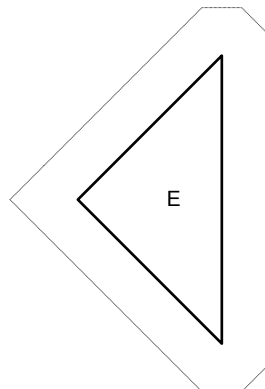
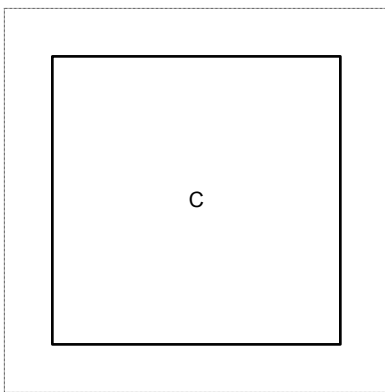
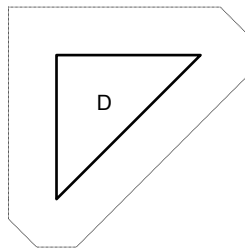
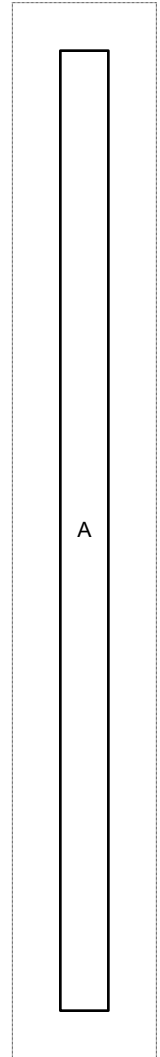
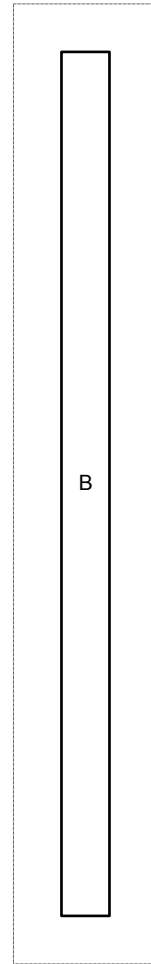
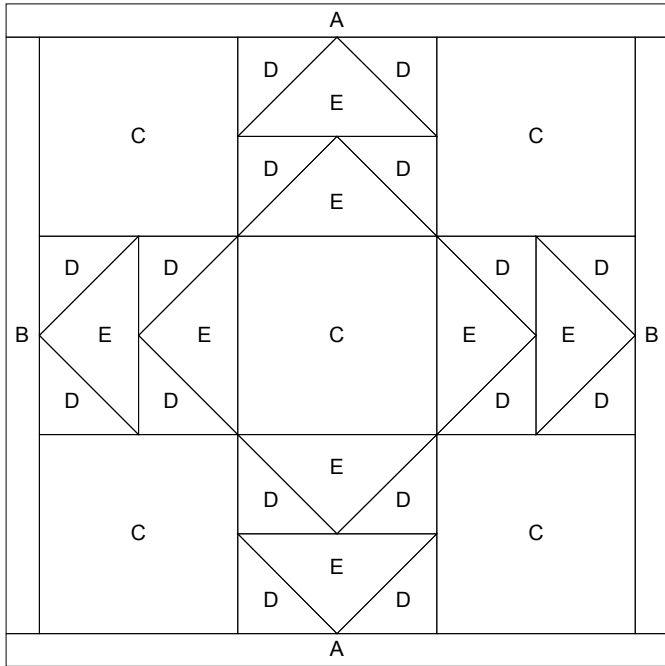


5. Join the two remaining flying geese units from Step 3 to the sides of the remaining Unit C as shown.
6. Join the rows from Step 4 and Step 5 as shown.
7. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
8. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure 5½" x 5½".
