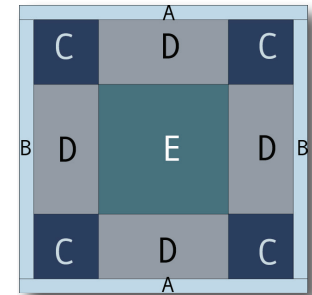


The Jane Stickle Quilt - Block A6

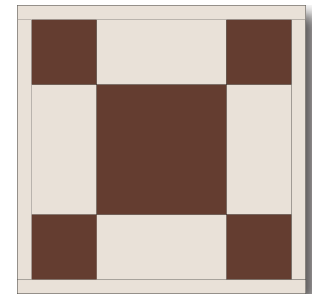


What you need:

Patches	Quantity/size
A*	(2) 1" x 6"
B*	(2) 1" x 5"
C	4 squares 1⅝" x 1⅝"
D	4 rectangles 1⅝" x 2¾"
E	1 square 2¾" x 2¾"

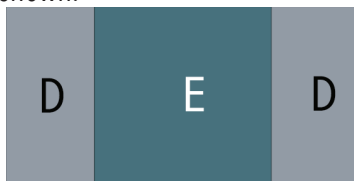
**The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is ¾". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly 5½".*

Assembly:

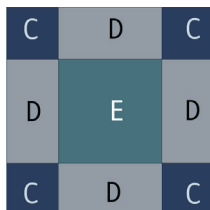
1. Attach Unit C to opposite sides of Unit D as shown. Make two.



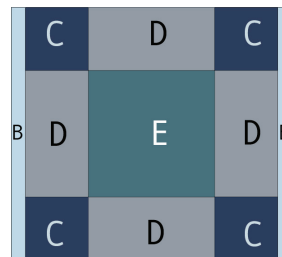
2. Attach remaining Unit D to each side of Unit E as shown.



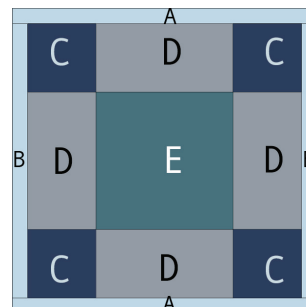
3. Sew together rows from Step 1 and Step 2 as shown.



4. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.

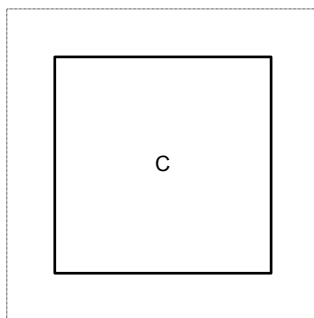
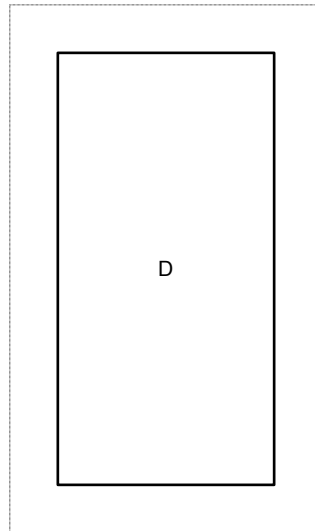
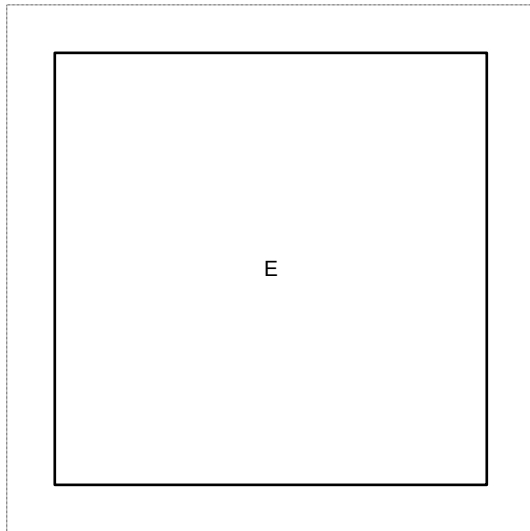
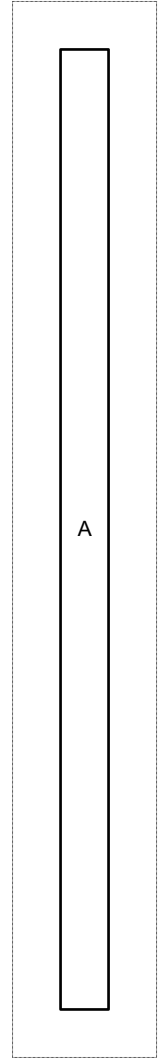
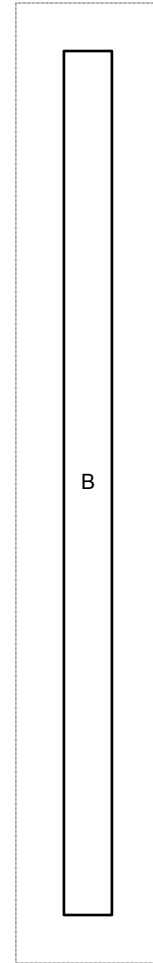
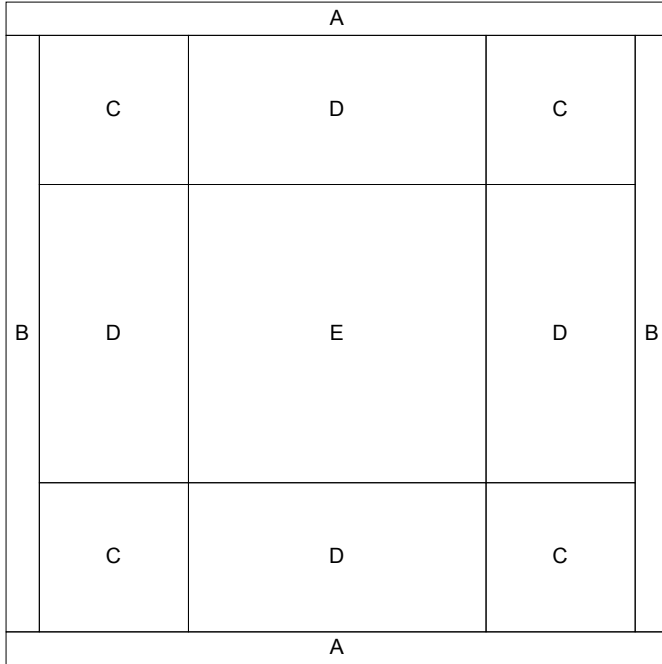


5. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure 5½" x 5½"
