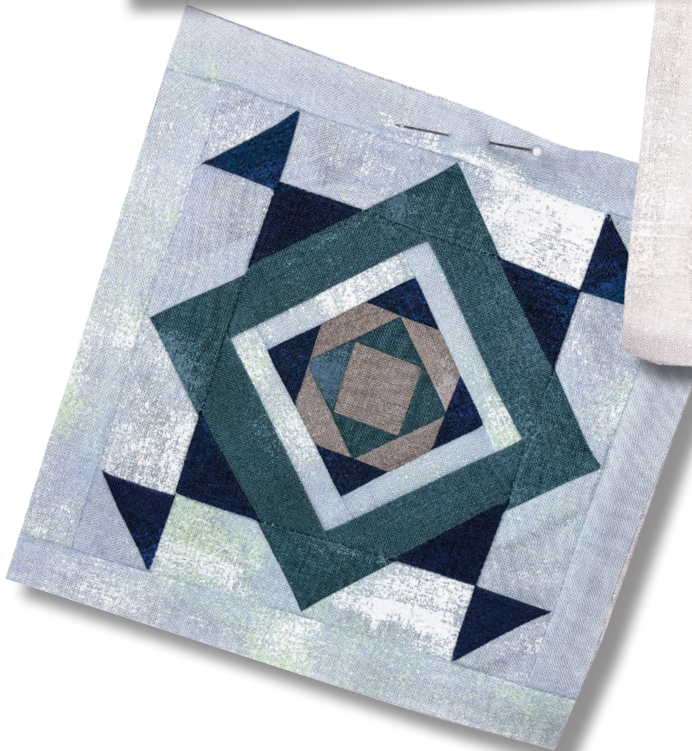
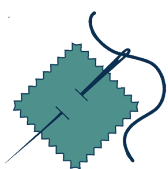


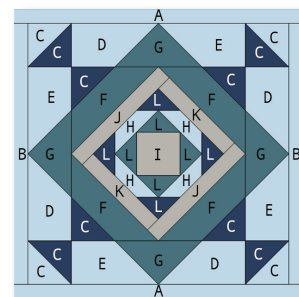
## The Jane Stickle Quilt - Block A9



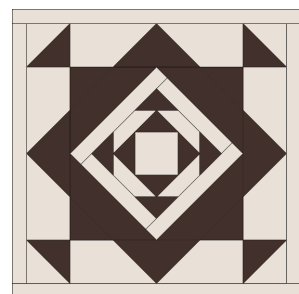


### What you need:

Patches	Quantity/size
A*	(2) 1" x 6"
B*	(2) 1" x 5"
C	2 squares 2" x 2", cut once diagonally-light blue 4 squares 2" x 2", cut once diagonally-navy
D	4 rectangles 2" x 3"
E	4 rectangles 2" x 3"
F	4 rectangles 1½" x 4"
G	1 square 3" x 3", cut twice diagonally
H	4 rectangles 1" x 3"
I	1 square 1½" x 1½"
J	2 rectangles 1" x 3"
K	2 rectangles 1" x 3"
L	1 square 3" x 3", cut twice diagonally-navy 1 square 3" x 3", cut twice diagonally-green



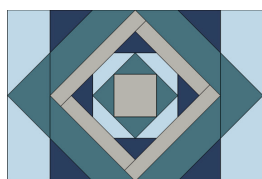

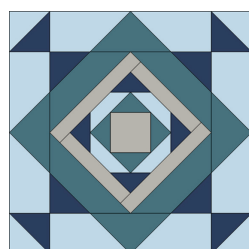

### Assembly:

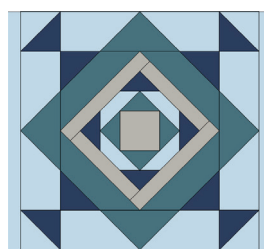
1. Using the templates provided on Page A9-2, create the five foundation sections.
2. Join the sections together.
3. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
4. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure 5½" x 5½"



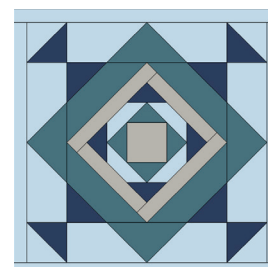

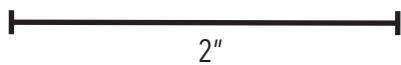
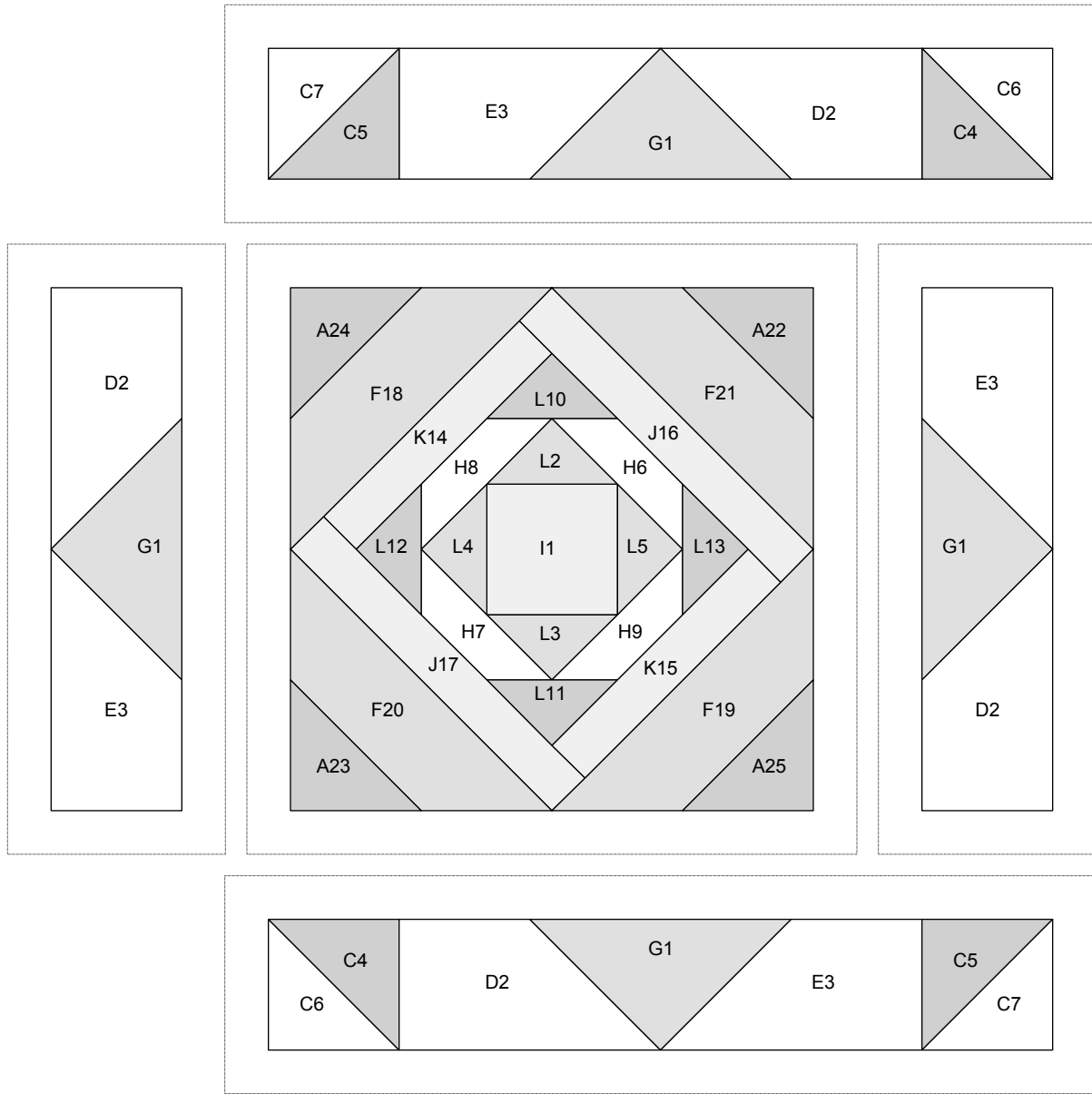
