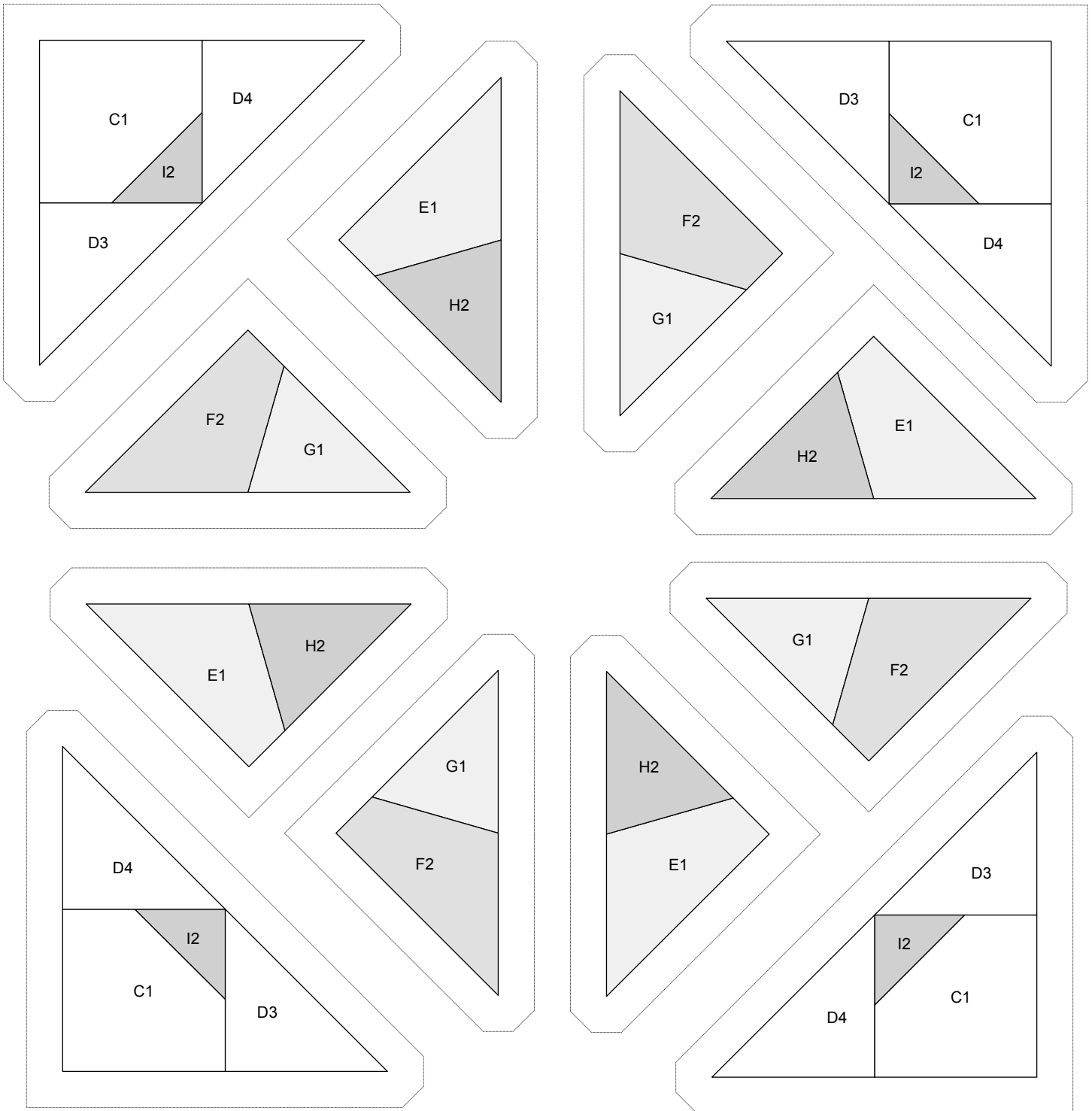
Assembly:

1. Use the templates provided on page A1-2, foundation piece the twelve sections of the block. Attach each fabric unit in the order numbered for each section. Join the sections as shown. The unfinished block should be 5" x 5" at this point.
2. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
3. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure 5½" x 5½" .

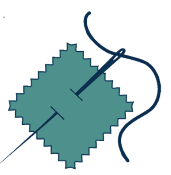

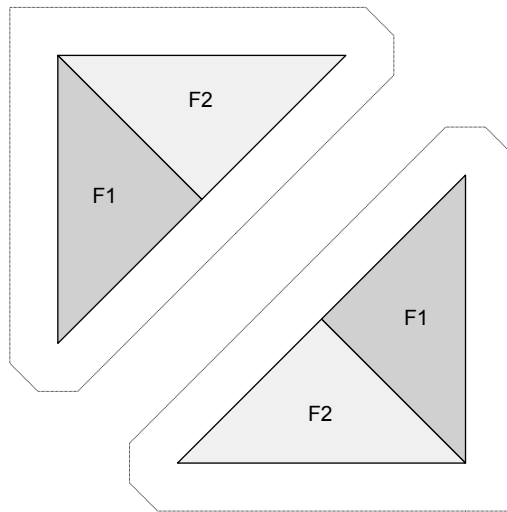
Assembly:

- Referring to BASIC INSTRUCTIONS for half-square triangles (HST) two at a time, layer a beige and a green Unit D. Make a total of four units. Arrange three Unit C and one Unit D HST to make a four patch. Make four.
- Referring to BASIC INSTRUCTIONS for stitch-and-flip flying geese, use two light blue Unit G with one navy Unit F to make each flying geese unit. Make a total of four light blue/navy flying geese units. Repeat the procedure with beige Unit G and green Unit F to make two beige/green flying geese units.
- Using block illustration as a color guide. Arrange two flying units (one of each color combination) and sew together as shown. Make two.
- Arrange units from Step 1 and Step 3 as shown. Sew together. Make two.
- For the middle section of the block, sew light blue/navy flying geese unit to a Unit E. Make two.
- Using the templates provided on Page A2-2, foundation piece Unit F quarter square triangle unit.
- Arrange units from Step 5 and Step 6 and sew together.
- Arrange units from Step 4 and Step 7 and sew together.
- Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
- Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure 5½" x 5½" .

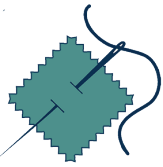

3. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure 5½" x 5½".

- Arrange flying geese units from Step 1 and Step 2. Sew together as shown. Make four.
- Join a Unit C to each side of a flying geese block from Step 3 as shown. Make two.

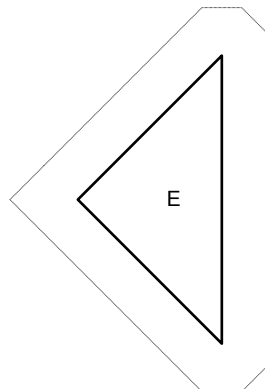
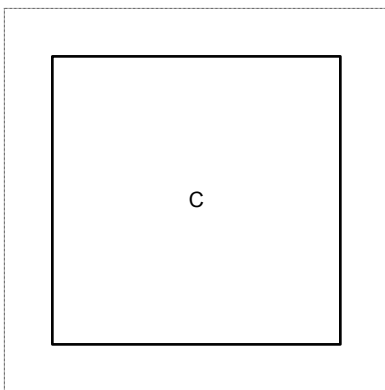
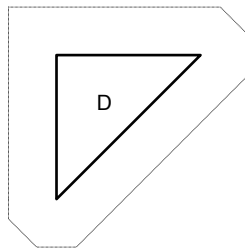
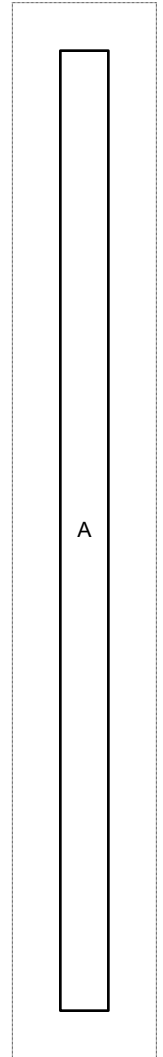
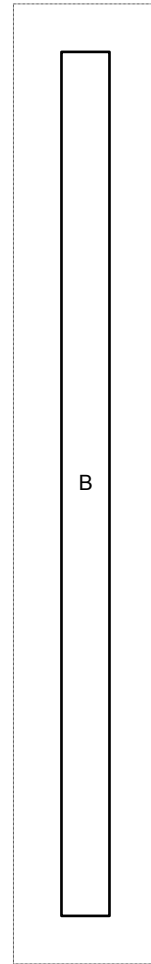
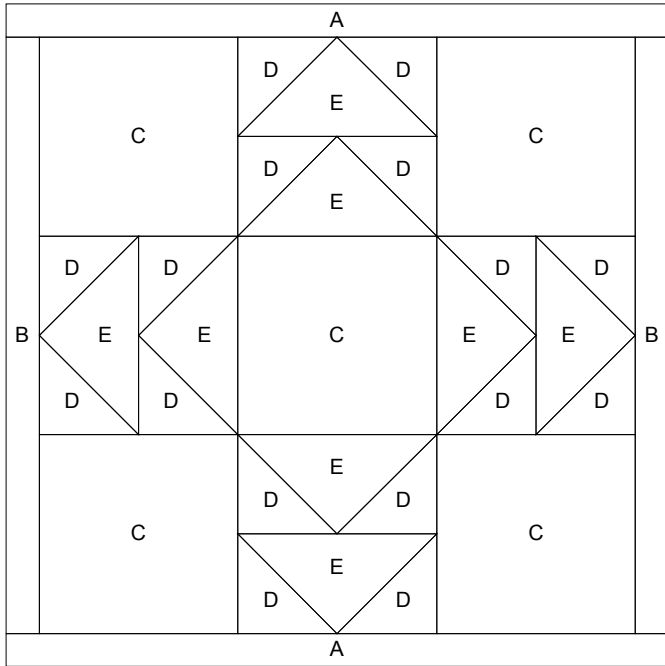
