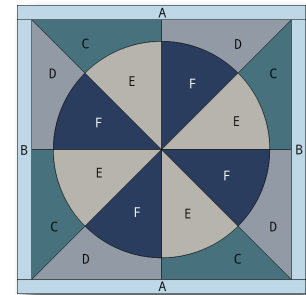


The Jane Stickle Quilt - Block B2

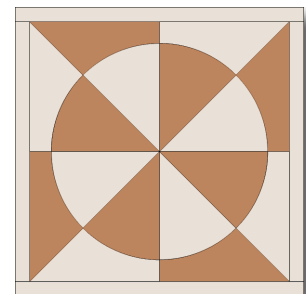


What you need:

| Units | Quantity/size |
|-------|---------------------|
| A* | (2) 1" x 6" |
| B* | (2) 1" x 5" |
| C | 2 squares 3½" x 3½" |
| D | 2 squares 3½" x 3½" |
| E | 2 squares 3½" x 3½" |
| F | 2 squares 3½" x 3½" |

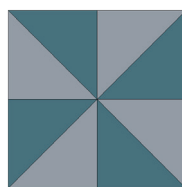

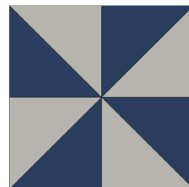
*The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is ¾". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly 5½".

Assembly:

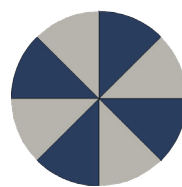
- Referring to BASIC INSTRUCTIONS for half-square triangles (HST) two at a time, use the gray Unit D and the green Unit C to make four HST units. Arrange the four HST units as illustrated and sew together.
- Repeat the process with the beige Unit E and navy Unit F patches to make four HST units. Arrange the four HST units and sew together.
- Using the circle template on Page B2-2, cut a circle from the Step 2 HST patch. Arrange the cut circle patch on top of the HST patch from step 1 and appliqué. Square block to 5" x 5".
- Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
- Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure 5½" x 5½"



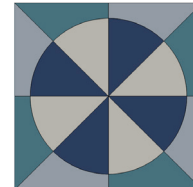
