
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
What you need:

Units	Quantity/size
A*	(2) 1″ x 6″
B*	(2) 1" x 5"
С	2 squares 31⁄2" x 31⁄2"
D	2 squares 31⁄2" x 31⁄2"
E	2 squares 31⁄2" x 31⁄2"
F	2 squares 31/2" x 31/2"

*The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is 34". The increased width specified


Jane Stickle Colorway

Assembly:

- 1. Referring to BASIC INSTRUCTIONS for half-square triangles (HST) two at a time, use the gray Unit D and the green Unit C to make four HST units. Arrange the four HST units as illustrated and sew together.
- 2. Repeat the process with the beige Unit E and navy Unit F patches to make four HST units. Arrange the four HST units and sew together.
- 3. Using the circle template on Page B2-2, cut a circle from the Step 2 HST patch. Arrange the cut circle patch on top of the HST patch from step 1 and appliqué. Square block to 5" x 5".
- 4. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.


above allows for squaring the block to exactly 51/2".

5. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure 51/2" x 51/2"





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
