


The Jane Stickle Quilt - Block B3




What you need:

Units	Quantity/size
A*	(2) 1" x 6"
B*	(2) 1" x 5"
C	2 squares 3½" x 3½" - navy 2 squares 3½" x 3½" - gray
D	2 squares 3½" x 3½" - beige 2 squares 3½" x 3½" - green

**The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is ¾". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly 5½".*



Assembly:

- Using the 2 navy Unit C and the 2 gray Unit C, assemble and sew together four patch unit.
- Repeat the process with the beige Unit D and green Unit D patches.
- Using the circle template on Page B3-2, cut a circle from the Step 2 four patch. Arrange the circle on top of the four-patch unit from Step 1 and appliqué the circle to the four patch. Square block to 5" x 5".
- Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
- Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure 5½" x 5½"
