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## What you need:

| Units | Quantity/size |
| :---: | :---: |
| A* | (2) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 6{ }^{\prime \prime}$ |
| B* | (2) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ |
| C | (2) $23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 23 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, cut once diagonally-green <br> (2) $23 / 4$ " $\times 233 / 4$ ", cut once diagonally-lt blue |
| D | (4) $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ |
| E | (1) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$ |

*The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is $3 / 4$ ". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly $51 / 2$ ".

## Assembly:

1. Using the templates provided on Page B9-2 or Page B9-5, create the foundation sections. Join the sections together.
2. Using the template provided on Page B9-3, applique the square piece to the block center. (Eliminate this step if using Page B9-5 templates.)
3. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
4. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
