## Assembly:

1. Using the templates provided on page B1-2 (appliqué) or B1-3 (hand piecing), appliqué the four circle units to Unit C of the block. When all the circles have been appliquéd to Unit C, trim the block to $5^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ square.
2. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
3. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure $5{ }^{1 / 21 "} \times 5^{1 / 2 "}$.

## What you need:



1. Referring to BASIC INSTRUCTIONS for half-square triangles (HST) two at a time, use the gray Unit D and the green Unit C to make four HST units. Arrange the four HST units as illustrated and sew together.
2. Repeat the process with the beige Unit E and navy Unit F patches to make four HST units. Arrange the four HST units and sew together.
3. Using the circle template on Page B2-2, cut a circle from the Step 2 HST patch. Arrange the cut circle patch on top of the HST patch from step 1 and appliqué. Square block to $5^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$.
4. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
5. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## What you need:



1. Using the 2 navy Unit C and the 2 gray Unit C , assemble and sew together four patch unit.
2. Repeat the process with the beige Unit $D$ and green Unit D patches.
3. Using the circle template on Page B3-2, cut a circle from the Step 2 four patch. Arrange the circle on top of the four-patch unit from Step 1 and appliqué the circle to the four patch. Square block to $5^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$.
4. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
5. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Assembly:

2. Join the sections together.
3. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
4. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## What you need:


*The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is $3 / 4$ ". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

## Assembly:

1. Arrange one Unit $G$ between one navy Unit $E$ and one green Unit $E ;$ sew together. Repeat for a second set.
2. Arrange Unit $F$ between the two units created in Step 1 and sew together.
3. Sew Unit D to the left side of unit created in Step 2. Sew second Unit D to the right side.
4. Sew Unit C to the top of the unit created in Step 3. Sew the second Unit C to the bottom.
5. Using the templates provided on Page B5-2, appliqué Unit H diamonds to the block created in Step 5.
6. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
7. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
