4. Arrange remaining two units from Step 2 with Unit E as shown and sew together.
5. Arrange units from Step 3 and Step 4 as shown and sew together.

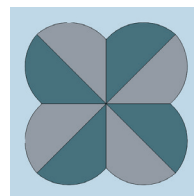
- Referring to BASIC INSTRUCTIONS for half-square triangles (HST) two at a time, use the green Unit D and the gray Unit E to make four HST units. Arrange the four HST units as illustrated and sew together.
- Using the template on page C5-2, cut clover shape from Step 1 patch. Appliqué patch to Unit C.
- Repeat the HST process using the beige Unit F and the navy Unit F to make four HST units. Arrange the four HST units as illustrated and sew together.
- Using the circle template on Page C5-2, cut a circle from the Step 3 HST patch. Arrange and appliqué the cut circle patch on top of the appliqué patch from Step 2. Square block to 5" x 5".
- Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
- Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure 5½" x 5½"



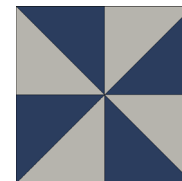
