

## The Jane Stickle Quilt - Block D2




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Unfinished Size: 5½" x 5½"

### What you need:

Patches	Quantity/size
<b>A</b> *	(2) 1" x 6"
B*	(2) 1" x 5"
C	(2) 1¾" x 1¾" - navy, cut once diagonally (2) 1¾" x 1¾" - green, cut once diagonally (2) 1¾" x 1¾" - light blue, cut once diagonally
D	(2) 1¾" x 3½"
Е	(2) 1 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " x 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> "
F	(2) 1 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " x 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> "
G	(2) 1¾" x 3½"
Н	(1) 2" x 2", cut twice diagonally
I	*The act (4) 21/2" x 21/2" units is lows for

\*The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is ¾". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly 5½".

### Assembly:

- 1. Using the templates provided on Page D2-2, foundation piece each section.
- 2. Join the four Unit I sections together to form a cloverleaf.

(1) 1¼" x 1¼"

- 3. Join the four light blue Unit C sections to the cloverleaf using inset seaming.
- 4. Join the remaining outer corner sections to the cloverleaf.
- 5. Reverse appliqué the center Unit J to the block.
- 6. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
- 7. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ "








