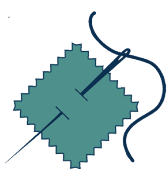


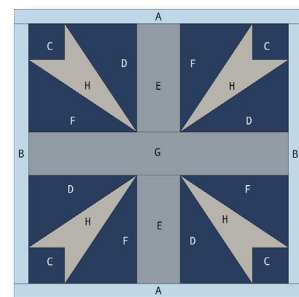
## The Jane Stickle Quilt - Block D12



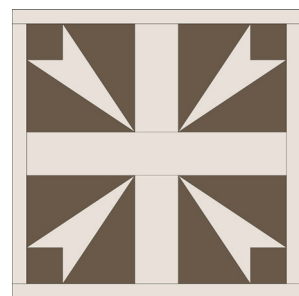


### What you need:

Patches	Quantity/size
A*	(2) 1" x 6"
B*	(2) 1" x 5"
C	(4) 1½" x 1½"
D	(2) 2½" x 3½", cut once diagonally
E	(2) 1½" x 3"
F	(2) 2½" x 3½", cut once diagonally
G	(4) 1½" x 5¼"
H	(4) 2" x 3"

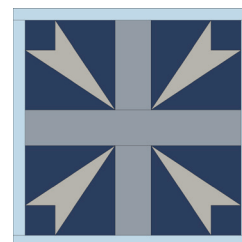
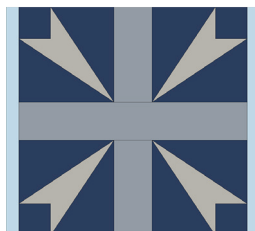

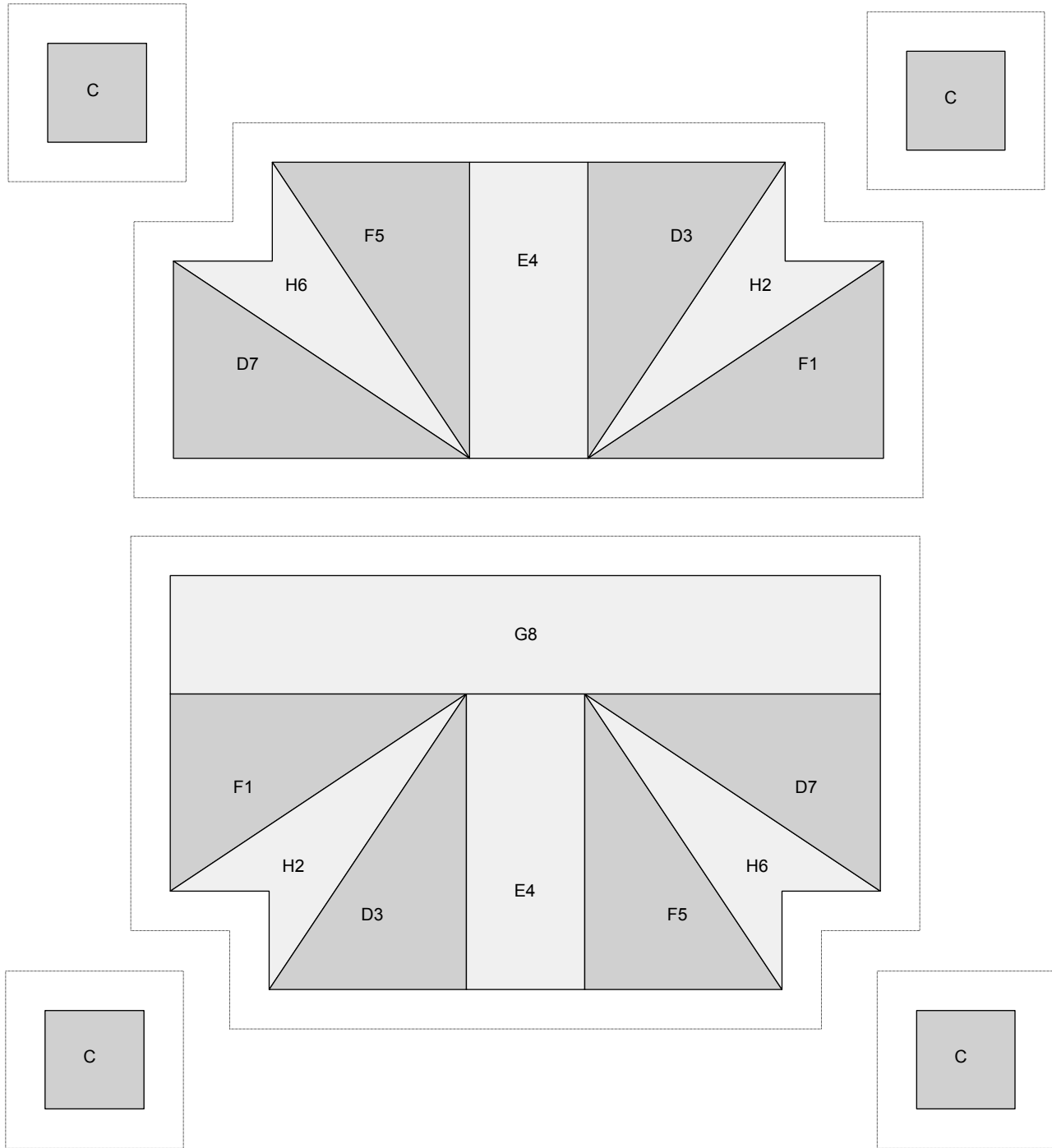
*\*The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is ¾". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly 5½".*

### Assembly:

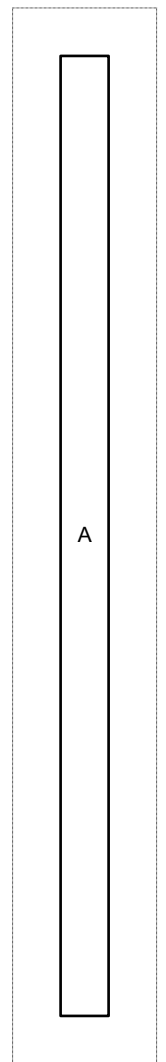
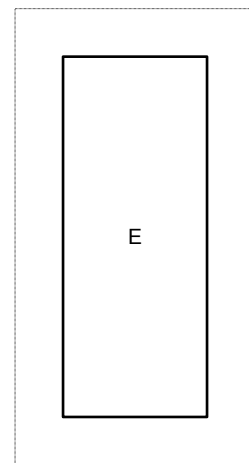
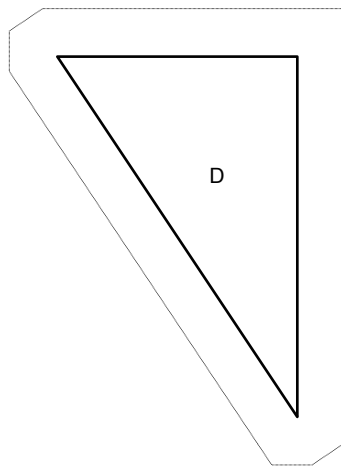
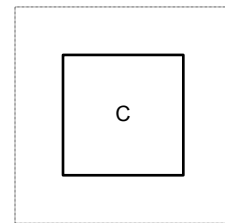
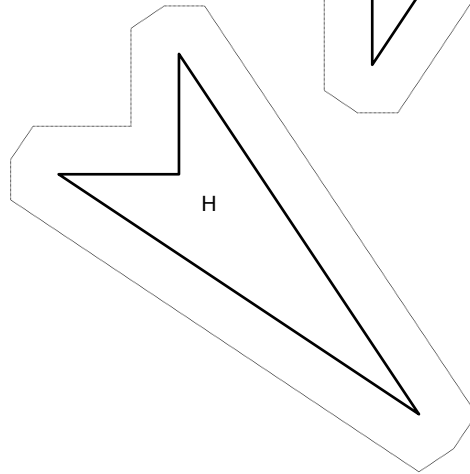
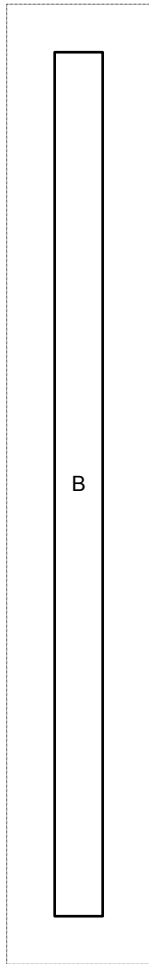
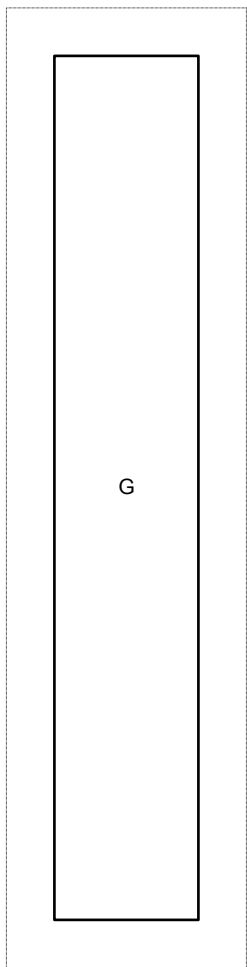
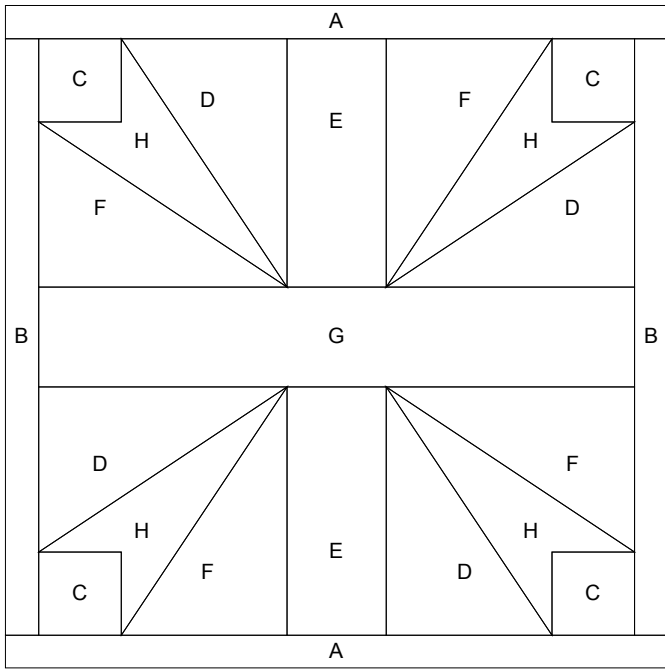
1. Using the templates provided on Page D12-2, foundation piece each section.
2. Join the sections together.
3. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
4. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure 5½" x 5½"



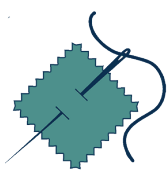

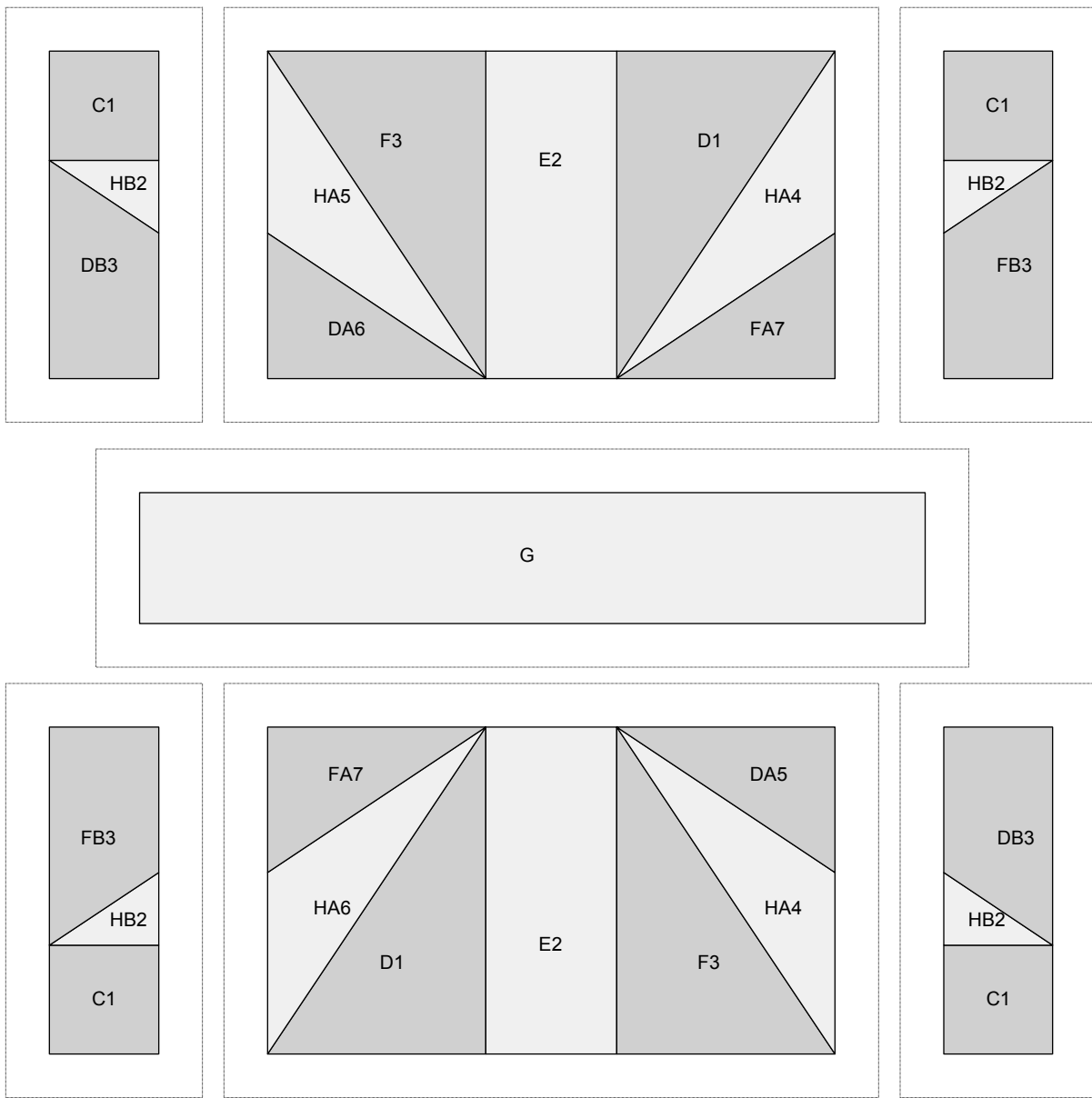
