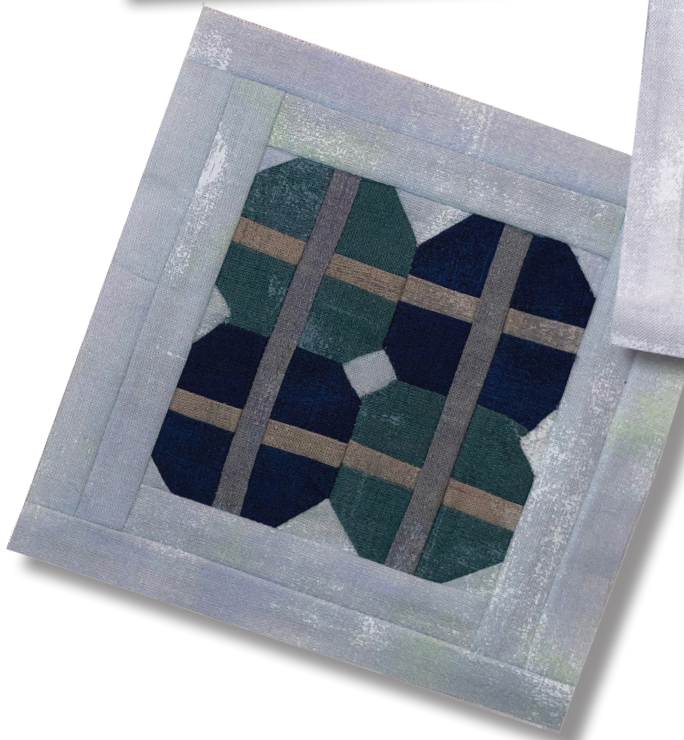
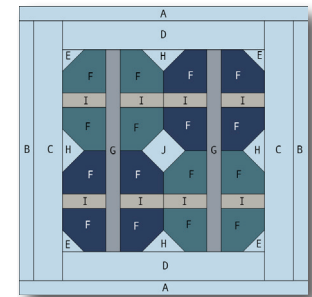


## The Jane Stickle Quilt - Block E7

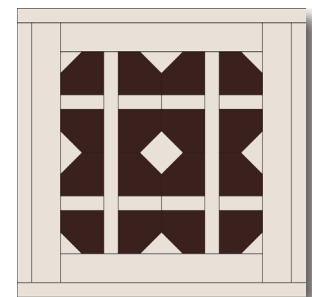


### What you need:

Patches	Quantity/size	Patches	Quantity/size
A*	(2) 1" x 6"	F	(16) 2" x 2"
B*	(2) 1" x 5"	G	(2) 1" x 4½"
C	(2) 1½" x 5½"	H	(1) 2½" x 2½", cut twice diagonally
D	(2) 1½" x 4½"	I	(8) 1" x 1½"
E	(2) 1½" x 1½", cut once diagonally	J	(1) 1½" x 1½"



Hobbystash Colorway

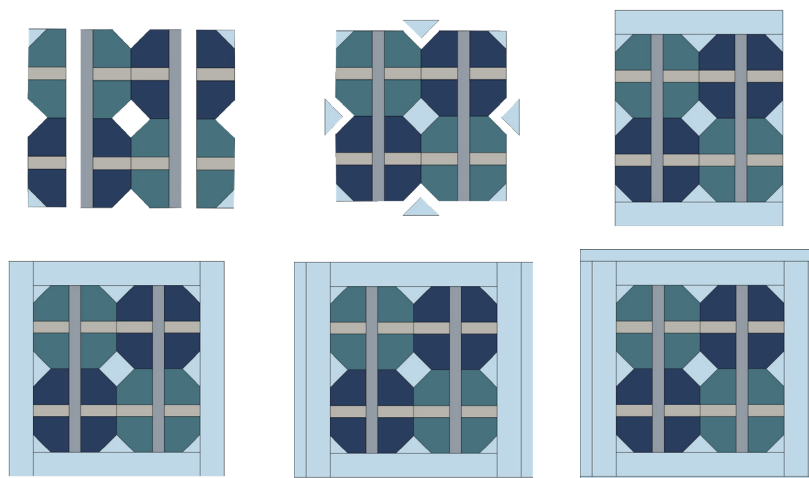

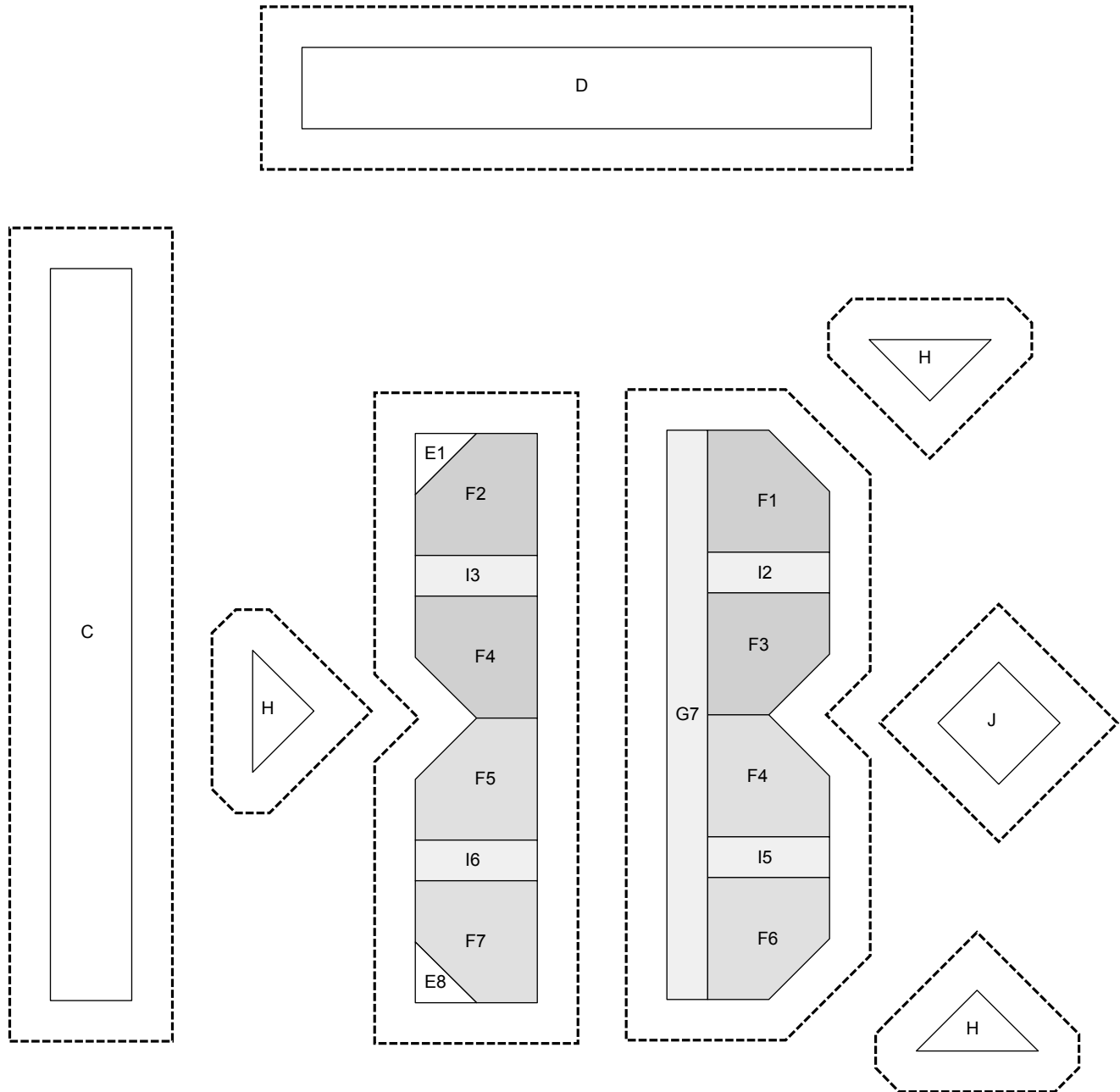
*\*The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is ¾". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly 5½".*

### Assembly:

1. Using the templates provided on Page E7-2, foundation piece each section.
2. Join the inner sections together.
3. Reverse appliqué the center Unit J square diamond to the block. Attach the Unit H triangles to the outer edges of the block as shown.
4. Join Unit D to the top of the block, and then the bottom.
5. Join Unit C to the right side of the block, and then the left.
6. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
7. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure 5½" x 5½".

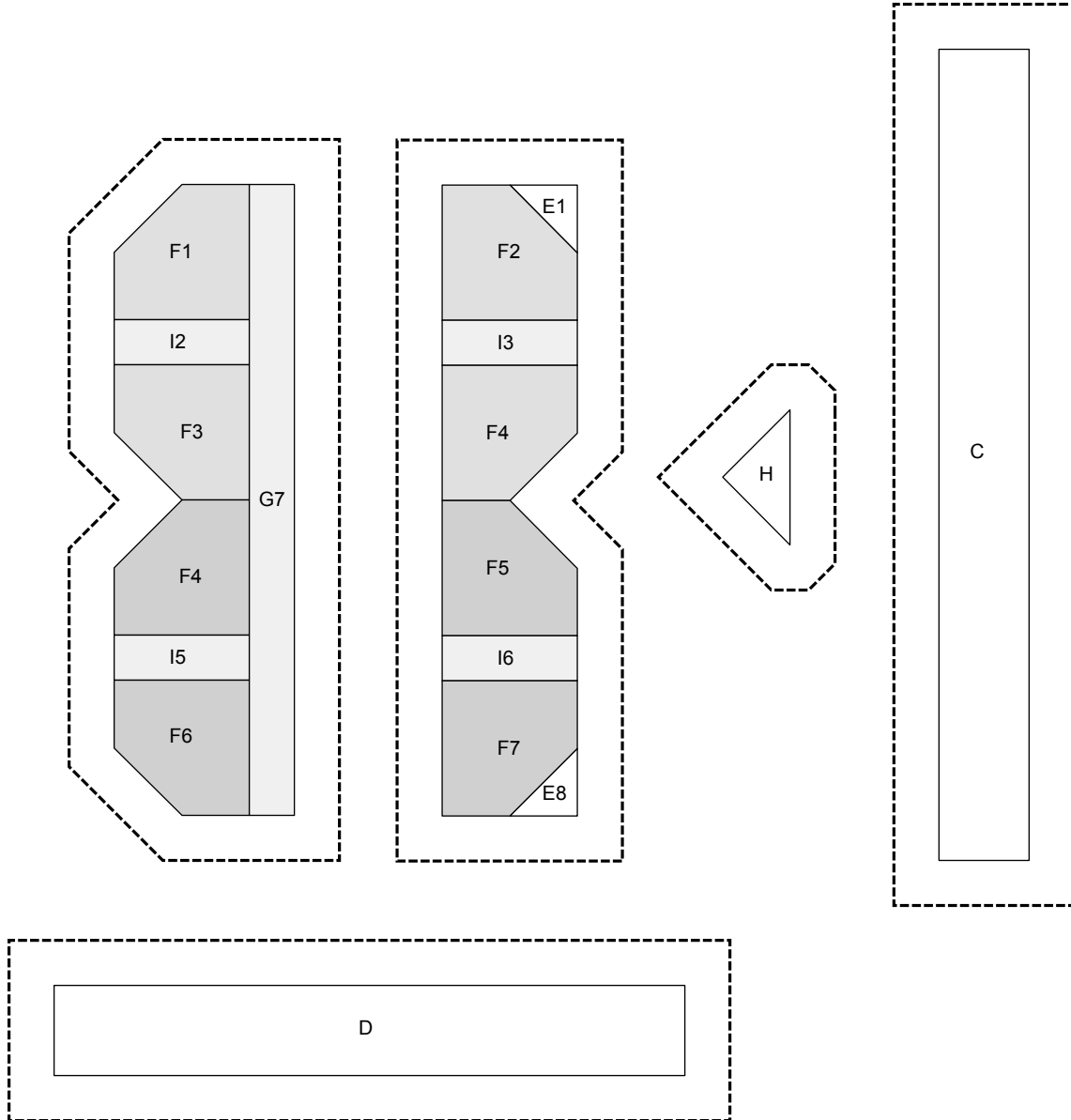
