

Unfinished Size: 5½" x 5½"

What you need:

Patches	Quantity/size
A *	(2) 1" x 6"
B*	(2) 1" x 5"
C	(2) 2½" x2½", cut once diagonally
D	(2) 2" x 2½", cut once diagonally
E	(2) 2" x 2½", cut once diagonally
F	(4) 2" x 21/2", cut once diagonally
G	(2) 2½" x 3" - beige (2) 2½" x 3" - gray
Н	(4) 2½" x 3"

*The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is ¾". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly 5½".

Assembly:

- 1. Using the templates provided on Page F2-2, foundation piece the sections of the block.
- 2. Assemble the sections and sew together.
- 3. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
- 4. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square.




