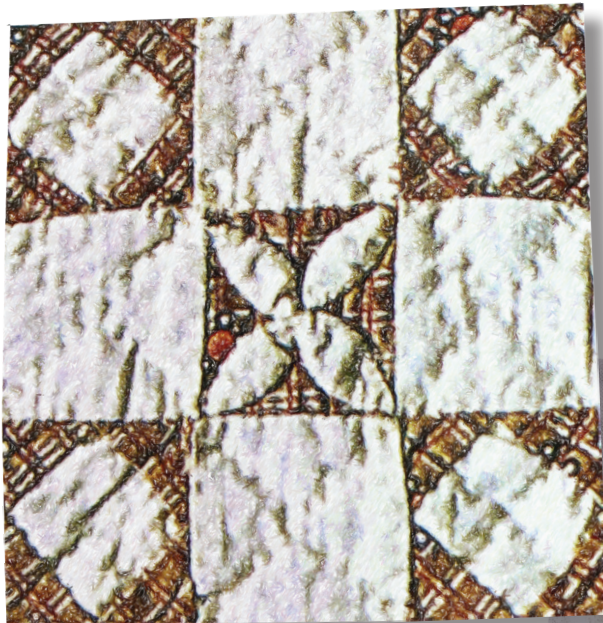



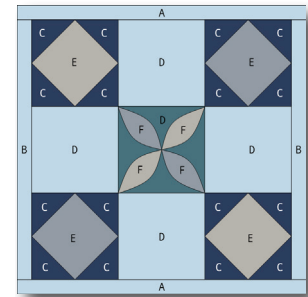
The Jane Stickle Quilt - Block F6



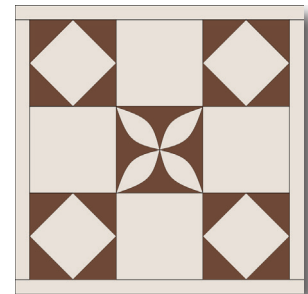
What you need:

Patches	Quantity/size
A*	(2) 1" x 6"
B*	(2) 1" x 5"
C 	(8) 2" x 2", cut once diagonally
D	(4) 2" x 2" - light blue (1) 2" x 2" - green
E	(2) 2" x 2" - beige (2) 2" x 2" - gray
F	(2) 1" x 2" - gray (2) 1" x 2" - beige

**The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is ¾". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly 5½".*



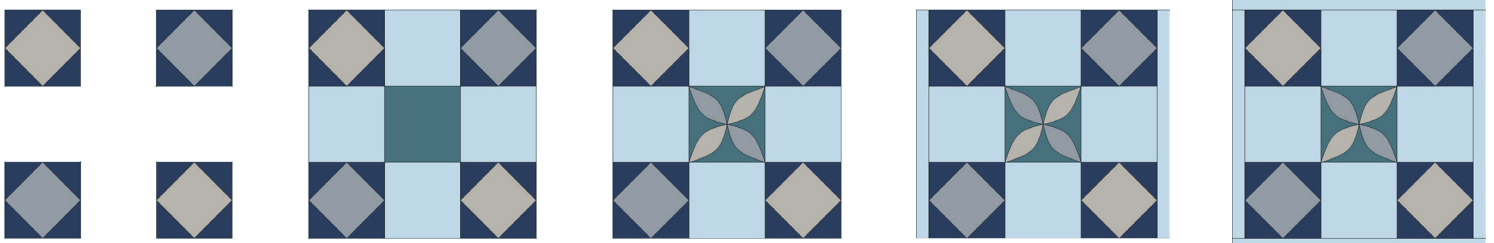

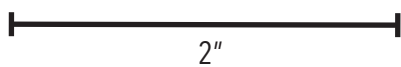
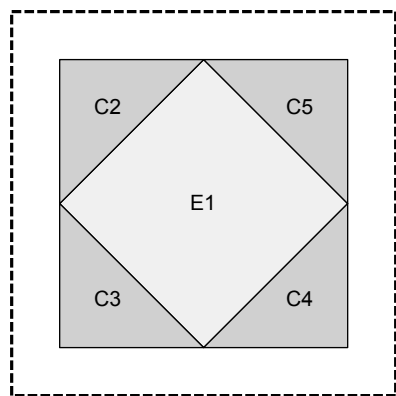
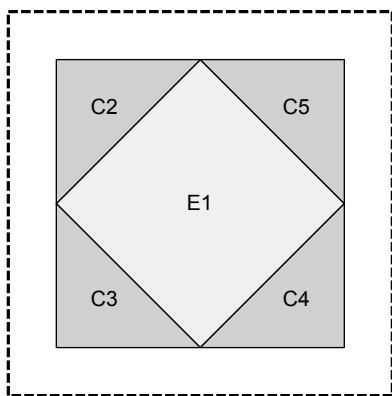
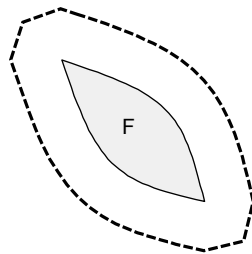
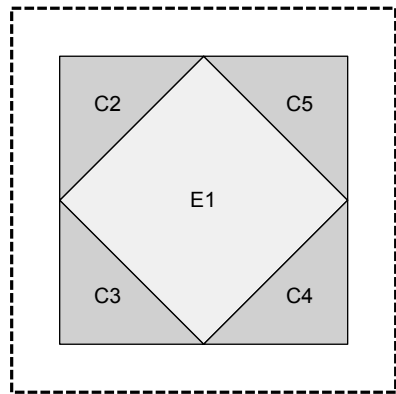
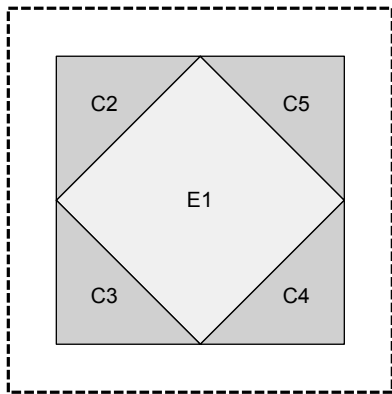
Assembly:

- Using the templates provided on Page F6-2, foundation piece the four outer corners of the block.
- Assemble the Step 1 sections with the five Unit D and sew together.
- Using the template provided on Page F6-2, appliqué four Unit F melons to the center square of the block.
- Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
- Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure 5½" x 5½" square.





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
