

## The Jane Stickle Quilt - Block F7




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
Unfinished Size: 51/2" x 51/2"

#### What you need:

Patches	Quantity/size
A*	(2) 1" x 6"
B*	(2) 1" x 5"
С	(4) 1" x 5"
D	(4) 1" x 41/8"
E	(4) 13/8" x 13/8"
F	(1) 3" x 3"
G	(4) 1¾" x 1¾"
Н	(1) 21/4" x 21/4"

\*The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is ¾". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly 5½".

### Assembly:

- 1. Following <u>BASIC INSTRUCTIONS</u> for *Flying Geese using "no waste" method*, use the Unit F and four Unit G to make four flying geese units.
- 2. Arrange one Step 1 flying geese unit between 2 Unit E as shown and sew together. Repeat for a total of two.
- 3. Arrange two Step 1 flying geese units on each side of Unit H as shown and sew together. Arrange completed row between the two rows created in Step 2 as shown and sew together.
- 4. Join Unit D to the top of the block and then the bottom.
- 5. Join Unit C to the rights side of the block, and then the left.
- 6. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
- 7. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
