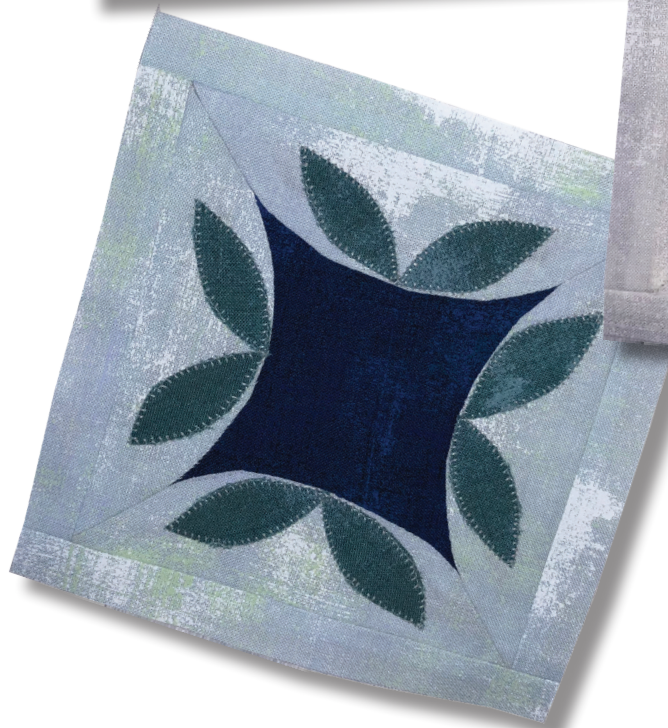
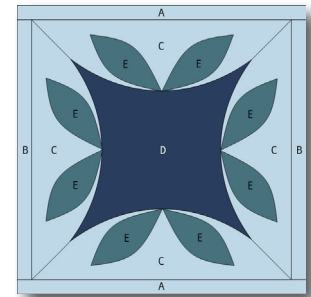


The Jane Stickle Quilt - Block F9

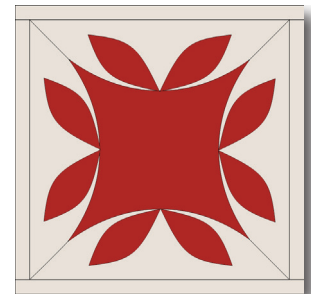


What you need:

Patches	Quantity/size
A*	(2) 1" x 6"
B*	(2) 1" x 5"
C	(4) 2" x 6"
D	(1) 5" x 5"
E	(8) 2" x 2"

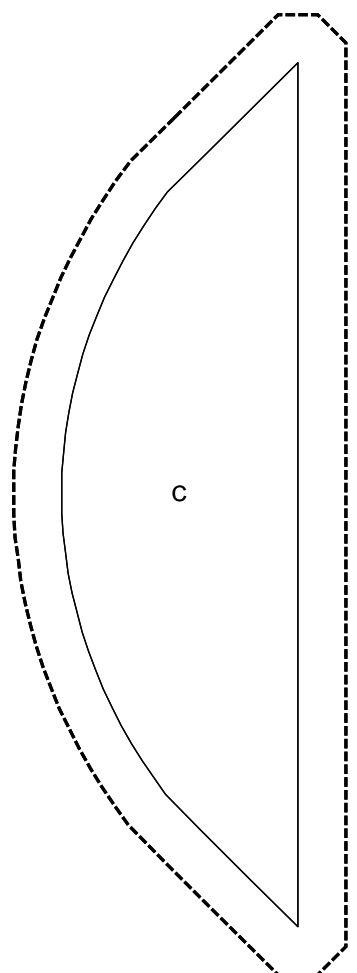
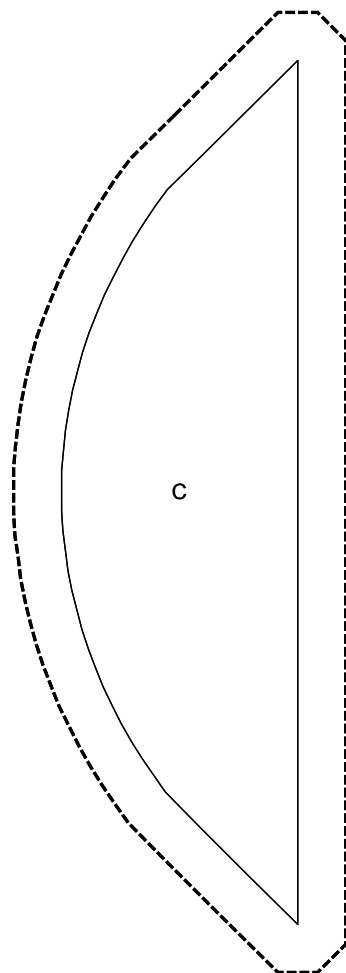
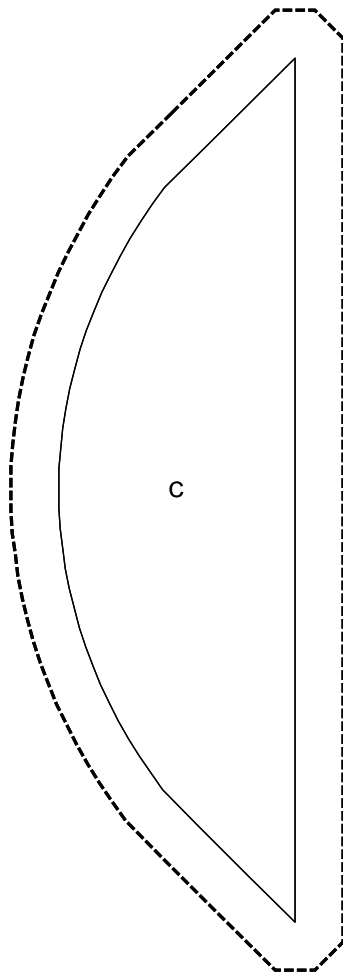
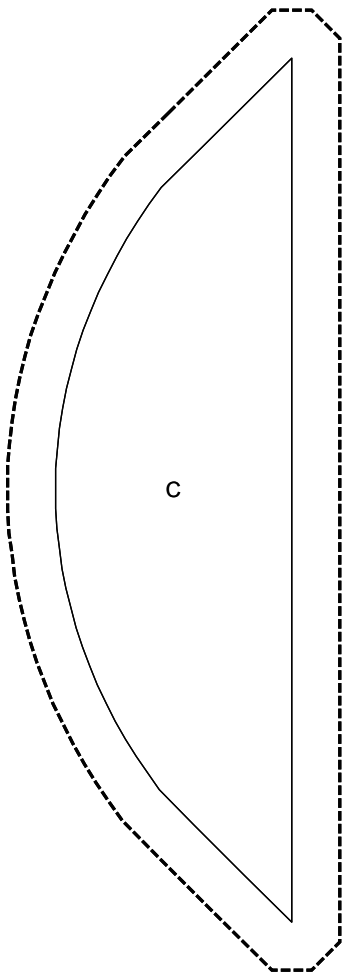
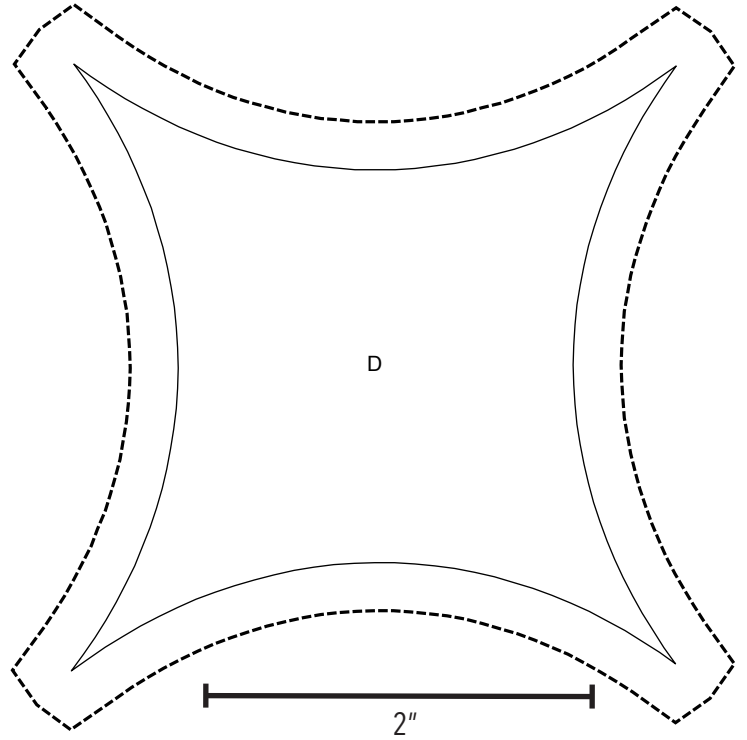
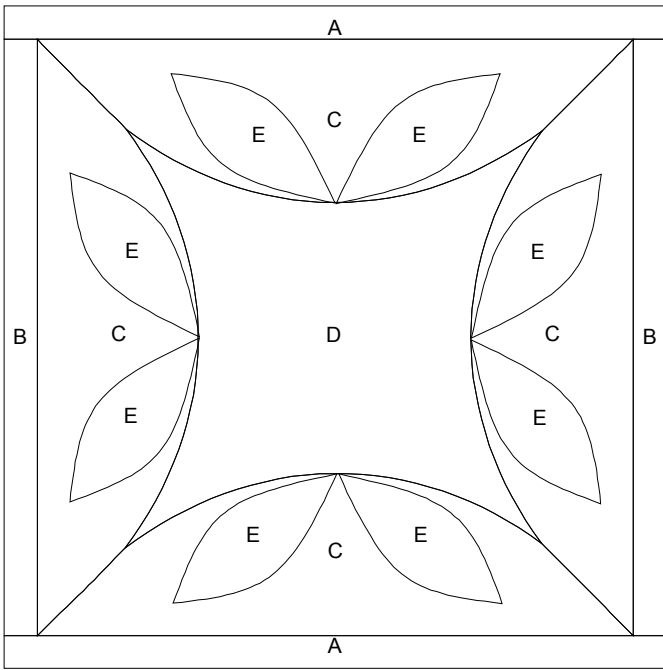
**The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is ¾". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly 5½".*

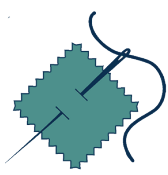
Assembly:

1. Using the templates provided on Page F9-2, arrange and sew together four Unit C at the corners.
2. Press under curved inner seam allowance for each Unit C. Appliqué to Unit D.
3. Using the template provided on Page F9-3, appliqué eight melons to the block.
4. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
5. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure 5½" x 5½" square.
